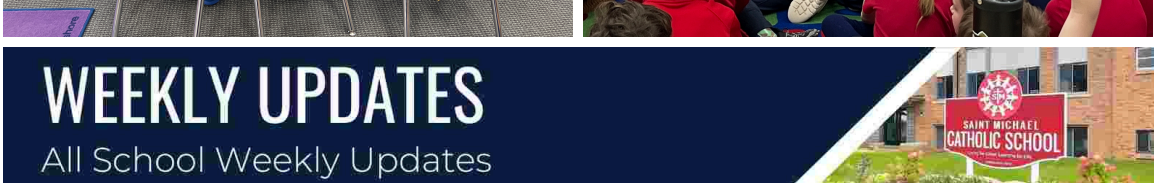
Dear StMCS Families,
