Anointing of the Sick Thursday, May 19, 11:00 am - St. Olaf Confession is available before Mass starting at 10 am

Who can be anointed?

Anyone who begins to be in danger of death may be anointed. This could include danger through old age, through illness, through serious surgery.

I've been anointed before. Can I be anointed again?

Anyone whose condition is worsened since their last anointing may be anointed again.

Is anointing of the sick the same as "last rites"?

The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is administered during periods of illness - often near the time of death - in order to bring the person receiving it spiritual and physical strength, courage, and peace so they can fight through their sickness and see the healing of God. As a sacrament, it is performed to give God's grace through the Holy Spirit.


