

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Novena and Celebration

On Sunday, **April 27**, at 3:00 p.m., our Parish will celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy, also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. In preparation for this Feast, we will pray the Divine Mercy Novena each day from Good Friday, **April 18**, through Saturday, **April 26**, at 3:00 p.m. in the church.

The Divine Mercy Devotion was revealed to a humble Polish nun, Sr. Faustina, by Jesus Himself during a series of visions in the 1930s. In the year 2000, Pope St. John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and proclaimed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth also be Divine Mercy Sunday.

Our Lord gave a great promise about this Feast: "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion [on Divine Mercy Sunday] will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." Jesus also asked that we do deeds of mercy for others, in return for His great mercy to us.

All are welcome to join us daily at 3:00 p.m. for this mercy and grace-filled devotion.
