Our Ministries

We have an immediate need for Altar Servers.

Becoming an altar server is a great way for children to serve and participate in the Mass. Teams of 2 or 3 servers are scheduled to serve approximately monthly at the 4pm, 9am and 11am Masses on a rotating schedule. Training is held annually and any child currently in grade 3 or above is invited to join.

We have two training dates scheduled for Wednesday, September 14 at 4:30 and Sunday, September 18 after the 9am mass. Attendance at one is necessary.

We have an immediate need for Children's Liturgy Volunteers.

Volunteers work in teams of 2-3 and we try to schedule teams for once a month. Everything you need will be provided for you. The children are gathered before the first reading. The priest will call the children to the altar for a blessing and the volunteers escort the children downstairs to the Murphy Room. A children's version of a Scripture is read, the children color or complete a craft while discussing the message.

Volunteers bring the children back to sit with their families as the Offertory song begins. It is approximately 15 -20 minutes.
