As many of you know, The Satanic Temple of Salem, MA is hosting their biggest convention yet, **Satancon 2023**, at the Boston Marriot Copley Place the weekend of April 28-30. The event is sold out and it is being promoted as "a weekend of blasphemy and remembrance in Boston." It also celebrates The Satanic Temple's 10th anniversary.

Earlier this week, Bishop Mark and representatives from surrounding shrines, parishes, religious orders, and RCAB staff met virtually and in person to discuss our response. A number of faith communities shared how they will be praying during that weekend. **Early next week we should have a list of worship sites complete with their prayer and adoration schedules.** In addition, the Secretariat for Evangelization and Discipleship collaborated with Pilot Printing to offer a "Pledge to Pray" prayer card to have in your pews for Masses on April 22-23

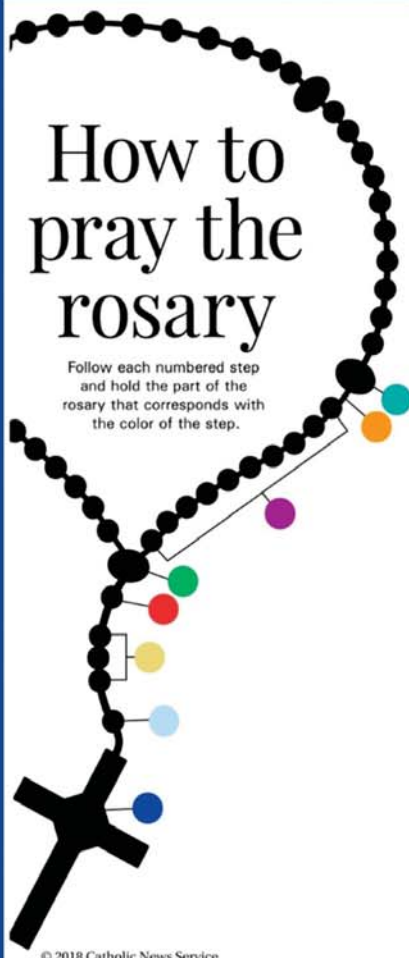
The card asks parishioners to pray a Rosary each day of the three-day convention. They are encouraged to put their name on the lower portion of the card and place it in the offertory basket. **The remainder of the card should go home as a reminder to pray on April 28-30.** This united prayer effort will be *our* way of protesting. We do not want anyone showing up at the Copley on the weekend of the event. This would only serve to excite all involved and draw negative attention.

We will be praying for the convention participants, hotel workers, and Mayor Wu. Why the mayor? Well, she tried to keep Satancon from coming to Boston and now they are dedicating this event to her.

Follow each numbered step and hold the part of the rosary that corresponds with the color of the step.

- 1 Make the Sign of the Cross and say the Apostles' Creed
- 2 Say the Our Father
- 3 Say three Hail Marys
- 4 Say the Glory Be
- 5 Announce the first mystery and then say the Our Father
- 6 Say 10 Hail Marys while meditating on the mystery
- 7 Say the Glory Be (Optional: Say the O My Jesus prayer requested by Mary at Fatima)
- 8 Announce the second mystery; then say the Our Father and repeat these steps as you continue through the remaining mysteries.
9. Say the Hail, Holy Queen
10. Make the Sign of the Cross

APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.
