Dear St. Louis de Montfort Parents,

St. Louis de Montfort School is planning to reopen for in person instruction next month, but we also recognize that some families are not comfortable sending their children to the campus yet. Conditions continue to change, but we want to share the options that will be available to you. Details regarding our expectations for parents, students, and staff will come later, but here are the ways in which your child can continue to grow academically, spiritually, and socially next year.

- In person on campus: Students will be physically distanced, wearing masks/shields, and have desk barriers for health and safety.
- Individual distance learning: Children will learn from home, watching live instruction from the classroom. This option is for students whose parents choose to keep them at home or must be at home for isolation/symptoms.
- School or Cohort distance learning: If the public health department, working with the Department of Catholic Schools and St. Louis de Montfort, determines that the entire school or one of our cohorts should work from home, then students will all participate in online classes.

We recognize that the choice to be on campus or in person is fluid, and your communication with the school will be very important - letting us know if your child is coming to school, distance learning by parent choice, home with symptoms, or if there is a confirmed case in your family. We have developed a draft of a SchoolSpeak form for you to share your daily plan with a few quick clicks.

Please continue to focus on messages from St. Louis de Montfort for information about our plans. Public school districts are making a variety of plans for the year to come, but our decisions are principally guided by the LA Archdiocese. Our school environment is not the same as a public school, and some of the challenges they face (such as transportation, accessibility, or meeting special needs) either do not apply to us or are challenges we have already resolved. We are grateful for your partnership and trust. Thank you for being part of this amazing family and for your patience as we continue adjusting to this new reality.
