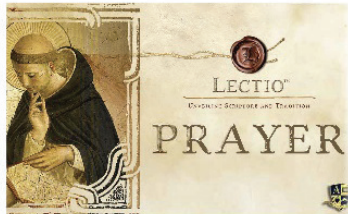

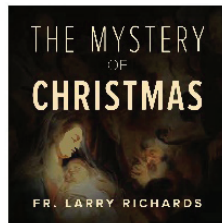

KIDS HOPE USA



Kids Hope is an ongoing program so mentors may join the program at any time during the school year. Several area churches are currently providing mentors for the program and more are needed.

The goal is to build a loving and dependable relationship between mentor and mentee. The mentor's initial work is to build a trusting relationship with the mentee through listening and kindness. Mentors spend the hour playing games, talking, and demonstrating reliability by simply being there. The mentee's interest often drives the direction of the relationship.

Kids Hope, USA is a national program serving over 15,000 children in about 1,000 programs in all 50 states. More information on Kids Hope, USA's history, objectives, and programs are available on the website: www.kidshopeusa.org.

Having the heart to serve and a love for children are the primary mentor qualifications. Mentors meet with their mentees for one hour every week during the school year. This school year, all mentors meet in the Elementary School Cafeteria on Tuesdays at 2:00 p.m.

Mentors complete one and half hours of online training and another one hour of in-person training. Additionally, each mentor must complete the background check required of everyone who volunteers in the school system.

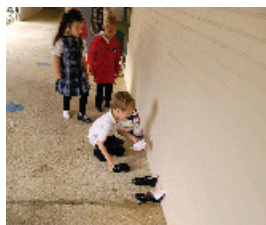

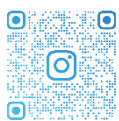
