The Sacraments: Sacred Encounters with God

The sacraments are sacred encounters with God, instituted by Christ, that nourish our faith and restore or strengthen our relationship with Him. Through these visible signs of grace, we experience His presence in profound ways. At Our Lady of the Gulf, we are blessed to celebrate all seven sacraments of the Catholic Church:

Baptism: The gateway to the Christian life, Baptism cleanses us from sin and welcomes us into God's family. A Baptismal Preparation Class is scheduled for **Thursday, August 7 at 6:00 p.m.** Contact Deacon Danny Rodgers to register: baptism@olgal.org.

Eucharist: The source and summit of our faith, where at every Mass, we receive the true Body and Blood of Christ. To prepare for First Holy Communion, contact Danielle Lee: CReEd@olgal.org.

Reconciliation (Confession): A sacrament of healing, offering God's mercy and forgiveness. Confessions are scheduled for Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 7:30 a.m., Wednesday 4:30 p.m., Saturday 4:00 p.m.

Confirmation: This sacrament strengthens us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and deepens our commitment to Christ. For youth (Grades 9–12), contact Phil Gazzo: teen@olgal.org. For adults, contact Mike O'Neil: ybcatholic@olgal.org.

Marriage: A sacred covenant between a man and a woman, mirroring Christ's love for His Church. For marriage preparation or information on getting married at OLG, visit: olgal.org/marriage.

Holy Orders: Through ordination, men are called to serve as deacons, priests, or bishops in the Church. Please continue to pray for vocations. If you think you might be called to Holy Orders, please reach out to Fr. Carucci as soon as possible.

Anointing of the Sick: A sacrament of healing and strength for those facing serious illness or advanced age. Anointing is available before or after Mass, or can be arranged at home or in the hospital. Contact our Caring Ministry Coordinator, Sara Pharmann: olgcares@olgal.org.

GETTING TO KNOW... DANIELLE LEE, COORDINATOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Q: Where did you grow up and did you go to CCD or Religious Education when you were a child?

Danielle: I was raised in Birmingham and went to Auburn University. After graduating, I did go back to Birmingham where I worked as a Pediatric Nurse. Growing up, I did go to Catholic School, so I did not participate in a CCD program.

Q: How long have you been here at Our Lady of the Gulf?

Danielle: We moved here in 2020, but I grew up coming to Gulf Shores for vacations, so I was familiar with the area and the parish.

Q: When did you start getting involved with religious education?

Danielle: Back in 2020, when my girls and I started attending Family of Faith here. I formally got involved with the Kindergarten through 8th grade program at the parish in 2022.

Q: How do you like the Faith of Family curriculum?

Danielle: It's great! The first weekend of the month, the parents meet with Father Carucci, while the children do what is called "pray and play." This gives the parents a chance to find out what topics or subjects we will be covering. During the next three weekends of the month, we meet together as a family and do activities and have discussions.



Q: Being that you have a family unit present, is the idea that what you teach will be more easily absorbed at home?

Danielle: Yes, it is our hope that the discussions we begin at Our Lady of the Gulf continue as the family goes home and lasts throughout the week and that the whole family can apply some of the lessons taught.

Q: Compared to some of the traditional CCD classes that have taken place in the Church over many years, Family of Faith appears to be unique in its approach.

Danielle: It stands out in that parents don't simply drop off their children. They are actively involved as their children learn the faith and it also helps when siblings can learn together. I think it is good to engage children in innovative ways and this curriculum allows for it

Q: When do the classes take place?

Danielle: They begin this September on Sunday mornings and take place between the 8:00 and 10:30 a.m. Masses. This gives families the option to attend one of two Masses together.

Q: What about sacramental preparation? How do you prepare?

Danielle: I do preparation for First Confessions and First Communions. We typically start in October for First Reconciliation. We'll meet on Wednesday nights from 6:00-7:00 p.m. for about seven weeks. The Sacrament of Reconciliation for our students will take place in December. We begin First Communion preparation during late February and have 8-9 Wednesday evening sessions. We typically have our students receiving their First Communion during the first week of May.

Q: What is the biggest challenge you face as Coordinator of Religious Education?

Danielle: Everyone is so busy and so just getting families together on a consistent basis can be a challenge.

Q: Does a family need to be parishioners in order to enroll into Family of Faith?

Danielle: Yes, but if they would like to check us out and see one or more of our lessons, they are more than welcome to come prior to registering at the parish.

Q: On August 9-10, Our Lady of the Gulf will be having a ministry fair following all of the Masses. Will you be attending?
