THE SACRAMENTS: ENCOUNTERS WITH CHRIST



The sacraments are sacred encounters with God, instituted by Christ, that nourish our faith and restore or strengthen our relationship with Him. Through these visible signs of grace, we experience His presence in profound ways. At Our Lady of the Gulf, we are blessed to celebrate all seven sacraments of the Catholic Church:

Baptism: The gateway to the Christian life, Baptism cleanses us from sin and welcomes us into God's family. A Baptismal Preparation Class is scheduled for **Thursday, August 7 at 6:00 p.m.** Contact Deacon Danny Rodgers to register: baptism@olgal.org.

Eucharist: The source and summit of our faith, where at every Mass, we receive the true Body and Blood of Christ. To prepare for First Holy Communion, contact Danielle Lee: CReEd@olgal.org.

Reconciliation (Confession): A sacrament of healing, offering God's mercy and forgiveness. Confessions are scheduled for Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 7:30 a.m., Wednesday 4:30 p.m., Saturday 4:00 p.m.

Confirmation: This sacrament strengthens us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and deepens our commitment to Christ. For youth (Grades 9–12), contact Phil Gazzo: teen@olgal.org. For adults, contact Mike O'Neil: ybcatholic@olgal.org.

Marriage: A sacred covenant between a man and a woman, mirroring Christ's love for His Church. For marriage preparation or information on getting married at OLG, visit: olgal.org/marriage.

Holy Orders: Through ordination, men are called to serve as deacons, priests, or bishops in the Church. Please continue to pray for vocations. If you think you might be called to Holy Orders, please reach out to Fr. Carucci as soon as possible.

Anointing of the Sick: A sacrament of healing and strength for those facing serious illness or advanced age. Anointing is available before or after Mass, or can be arranged at home or in the hospital. Contact our Caring Ministry Coordinator, Sara Pharmann: olgcares@olgal.org.

The Family of Faith program is set to resume in September. If you are a new member of the parish or have a child entering Kindergarten, we warmly welcome you to our community. The Family of Faith program is open to all parish families, including those whose children are just beginning their faith journey in Kindergarten. Early participation is encouraged, as the program gradually introduces children and parents to the teachings and values of our parish family.

Family of Faith has replaced "CCD" and offers a setting where parents and children participate in group learning, activities, and prayer, with a focus on the teachings and values of the community.

Program Structure:

Each month, Fr. Carucci presents topics to parents, followed by small-group discussions and related activities, while children engage in Pray and Play with catechists. Weekly at-home sessions provide opportunities for families to continue faith-based learning together.

Family of Faith is the main preparation program for **First Reconciliation and First Communion**. Children should start by First Grade to receive First Holy Communion in Second Grade.

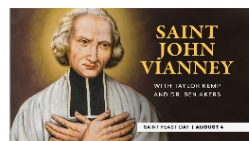
The Transfiguration | Sacred Art

CARE MINISTRY: A PARISH FAMILY IN ACTION

The Care Ministry is committed to extending the care and compassion of Our Lady of the Gulf beyond parish boundaries. WHAT WE DO

Visits & Fellowship: Trained volunteers conduct regular visits to residences, hospitals, and nursing facilities, offering conversation, encouragement, and empathetic support.

Prayer Support: We provide spiritual assistance through prayer with and for those in need, distribute personalized prayer cards, and include intentions in the parish prayer chain.

Communion & Sacraments: Upon request, we deliver the Eucharist to those unable to attend Mass and facilitate arrangements for the Anointing of the Sick.

WHO WE SERVE

- Individuals who are elderly, ill, recovering from surgery, or otherwise unable to attend Mass.
- Families and caregivers seeking spiritual support for loved ones.
- Community members facing loneliness or adversity who would benefit from a supportive visit.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- Refer a Neighbor: Please notify us regarding any parishioners absent from Mass or individuals in need so we may offer outreach.
- Join Our Team: No specialized training is required; orientation and ongoing support are provided to all compassionate volunteers.

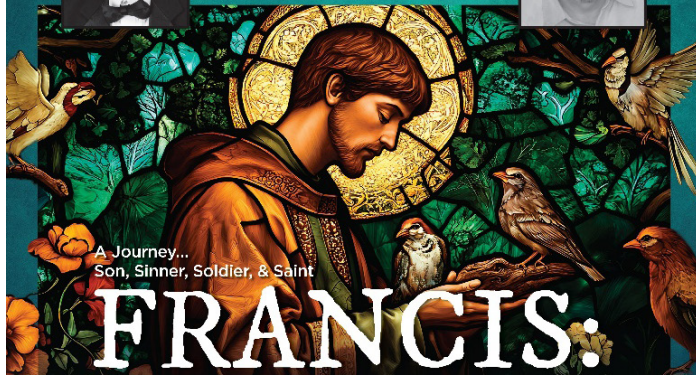

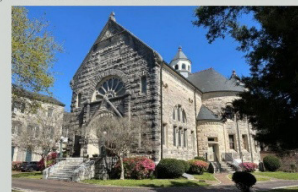
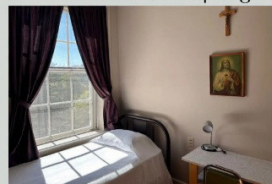

GETTING TO KNOW... CECIL DUBUISSON, ALTAR SERVER

Q: Where are you originally from and how did you discover Gulf Shores?

Cecil: I was raised on the Mississippi Gulf Coast. My parents brought us here as kids on vacation. My wife, Betty, and I brought our kids down here for vacations. We always loved it here and, so after retiring from FedEx after 31 years, we have made Gulf Shores our home. We have been parishioners here at Our Lady of the Gulf now for seven years.

Q: How long have you been an Altar Server?

Cecil: I started when I was a boy back in Third grade.

Q: What is it about Altar Serving that inspires you?

Cecil: It's just a way to feel closer to God. Yes, I can feel close to God by sitting in the pew at Mass, but it is different when you are serving the priest, who is representing Jesus at the altar during Mass. It is wonderful.

Q: Did you always feel this closeness?

Cecil: Yes, even back when I was in Third grade.

Q: We don't think that Altar Servers can face many distractions during a Sunday Mass with hundreds of people in front of them. How do you keep from being distracted?

Cecil: It helps me by just concentrating on the priest. I'm there to serve the priest and I just keep my focus on him. Also, I focus on the Word when it is read. After all these years, it just comes natural for me.

Q: Many of the Masses at the parish have two Altar Servers assigned, even during the week.

Do you prefer to work with someone else?

Cecil: It doesn't matter. I enjoy serving by myself, but sometimes there are extra duties, and it is good to be working with another person.

Q: If you have the choice of processing in and out with the cross at Mass or ringing the bells at the consecration, which do you prefer?

Cecil: Carrying the cross.

Q: What words of encouragement might you give to a parishioner who may be considering becoming an Altar Server?

Cecil: You really can't imagine the closeness and the joy of serving at the altar. There are no words that can describe being so close to Christ.
