



It's often said that the Catholic Church lays heavy rules on her members, rules that can almost seem impossible. Mass *every Sunday*? No lying *ever*? Sexual purity *all the time*? I recently said to some non-Catholic friends that more than fifty adults were baptized at my parish at the Easter Vigil. One responded spontaneously with shock, "Why would anyone do *that*?" In other words, why would someone willingly place themselves in a system with such demanding and rigorous rules?

Of course, no one in the history of religions is more demanding and rigorous than Jesus himself. In the Sermon on the Mount, he says you have to be holier than pharisees or you're out. He says if you call someone a fool, you go to fiery Gehenna. He says you can't even look at a woman with lust or you're guilty of adultery (which was punishable by death). To top it all off, he says you can't even get divorced and re-married. Doesn't he know these are basically impossible demands? What world is he living in?

The new one, actually. He is the new world. Jesus' words aren't meant to condemn. They are meant to signal something new, a restored humanity. Jesus doesn't just give external laws; he gives us his Holy Spirit to internalize the law through love. He wants to fill us with his love. That's what the Church exists to do. Love demands extraordinary things. The "demands" of the Church only make sense because she is filled with Jesus' love. That wildly demanding love is why we are Catholic.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK EXAMPLES OF OUR FAITH

### Short Bio

Blessed James Miller, the second ever U.S.-born martyr, served as a missionary and educator to the poorest of the poor in Nicaragua and Guatemala. Shot to death in front of his students in 1982, his legacy of love lives on today through the many schools he started.

La Primera Lectura ayuda grandemente para clarificar el pensamiento y disponer el corazón a la Palabra iluminadora de Dios: "*Si túquieres, puedes observar los mandamientos; está en tus manos el ser fiel. Ante ti puso el fuego y el agua: extiende la mano a lo que prefieras. Delante de los hombres están la vida y la muerte, a cada uno se le dará lo que ha elegido*" (*Sirácides 15,15-17*). Significa que somos responsables de nuestros propios actos. Los actos de culto no están ajenos de los actos de justicia por una sociedad mejor. Deseo que, en esta Eucaristía, descubramos la sabiduría de Dios que tanto necesitamos, que no cerremos nuestro corazón a lo que ya sabemos, sino que descubramos los nuevos horizontes de Jesús en sus enseñanzas. ¡Así sea!





When children are unsupervised online, it is difficult to know who they come in contact with, so knowing the warning signs that they might be talking to an online predator is important. Talk to your children about appropriate and inappropriate conversations online. Red flags of online enticement include engaging in sexual conversation, asking for sexually explicit images, or offering incentives like gift cards, free lodging, transportation, or food. ### SENTIMIENTOS Y COSAS BRILLANTES

Una amiga mía tiene una tradición en el primer cumpleaños de sus hijos. Se colocan tres artículos, una moneda, un vaso de trago y un rosario, frente al niño de un año, y cualquier objeto que agarre supuestamente le da una idea de su futuro. Una moneda promete riqueza, el rosario indica bondad y el vaso de trago... bueno, estoy segura de que puedes adivinar.

Por supuesto, el niño solo agarra lo que se ve mejor. Realmente no están eligiendo dinero o a Dios o una fiesta. Su elección se rige por el impulso.

En estos días, "No lo siento" es una excusa genuina para evitar algo. "Siento eso", decimos para indicar acuerdo. "Siento que..." es una forma aceptable de ofrecer nuestra opinión. Los sentimientos tienen mucho peso.

Antes de Cristo, solo existía la ley, y la ley se ocupaba principalmente de las acciones. Haz esto. No hagas esto. Todo muy bien. Pero con el cumplimiento de la ley, Cristo quiere que miremos hacia adentro. Quiere que consideremos la influencia de nuestros sentimientos en nuestras acciones y que entendamos cómo nuestras acciones elegidas pueden, a su vez, inspirar ciertos sentimientos.


Soy milenaria, así que, dependiendo de tu edad, puedes pensar que siento demasiado o que siento muy poco. Sin embargo, una cosa que he aprendido es que cuando doy rienda suelta a mis sentimientos, mis instintos se convierten inmediatamente en acciones. Me convierto en el niño que agarra objetos brillantes sin pensar en lo que representan. La ira se convierte en poca amabilidad. Los celos se vuelven crueldad. El miedo se convierte en egoísmo.



### BLESSED ST. JAMES MILLER

Blessed Brother James Miller, martyred in Guatemala at age 37, was born September 21, 1944, in Wisconsin. Ordained to the Lasallian Christian Brothers in 1969, his first assignment was as a teacher at Cretin High School in St. Paul, Minnesota. During the three years he was there he taught Religion, English, Spanish, and coached the school's soccer and football teams. Despite his success at Cretin, his deepest desire was to serve the poorest of the poor as a missionary educator.

Eventually the Lasallians sent him to Nicaragua where he served for 19 years. During his time in the country, he



supervised the construction of ten new rural schools, helped build an industrial arts and vocational complex, and worked with the Nicaraguan Somoza government on education initiatives. During his time as director of a school in Puerto Cabezas he increased the school's population of students from 300 to 800!

In 1979, when the Sandinistas revolution began in Nicaragua, the Lasallians recalled him to the United States for his own safety. Despite his displeasure at this reassignment, he returned to Cretin High School in St. Paul as a teacher but longed to go back to the mission field, writing to his superiors, "I am anxious to return to Latin America." By 1981 his order would grant his request and send him to a new country, Guatemala, where he taught English, Religion, and Guatemalan art to secondary students at a Lasallian Brothers school in Huehuetenango. He also established relationships with local families, often the poorest of the poor, teaching job and leadership skills to native adults.

On the afternoon of February 13, 1982, while out fixing a school fence post, Brother James Miller was murdered. He was shot several times by three men and died instantly in broad daylight in plain view of many of his students. His assassins were never caught. Some claim his murder may have been because of his order's work to prevent the government from illegally and forcibly conscripting native men into the military. His death came during a time when other priests and religious figures were also being assassinated in Guatemala. The Brother James Miller Fund was established after his death to continue his work for the poor and oppressed and in 2018, Pope Francis approved a decree recognizing Brother Miller as a martyr.




