



## AN UPDATE ON FATHER BILL'S HEALTH ISSUES

#### **ONE PRIEST:**

## Father Bill Only Priest Here Most of September

**Father Jim on sick leave.** At his request his health issues are confidential. It is assumed that he may be on sick leave for 3 to 6 weeks.

**Father Albert on pilgrimage.** For most of September Fr. Albert will be away on pilgrimage. Arrangements and commitments were made months ago and he very much deserves this.

**Father Bill recovering:** While in good health, he continues to recover from 3 major orthopedic surgeries the past 18 months and must still use a walker. He tires easily. It will be impossible for him to respond to sick calls. He will be available only for a limited number of funeral Masses, but unable to cover graveside services.

**Shortage of Priests:** There is a severe shortage of priests worldwide and an aging priesthood. The average age of priests in SoCal is 71. Parishes and all aspects of Church life must adapt to this painful and disappointing situation. The Archdiocese is looking for a priest to help us for a month or two, but there are no promises. So that we are not making last minute decisions we are planning ahead to make necessary cutbacks in our Mass schedule.

**Fr. Bill's Concerns Are:** To cover Sunday and Holydays Masses, next emergency sick calls, then funerals, also hopefully one Mass daily on weekdays. Confessions may be put on hold till after this parish crisis.

## Temporary Sunday Mass Changes Sept. 5 through 19 inclusive Three Weekends

## 6:30am ONLY Temporarily Canceled

- 1. Saturday evening at 5:30pm will continue as the Vigil Mass for Sunday.
- 2. Sunday morning at 6:30am will be CANCELED for these three weekends, no Communion Service at 6:30am. This is because we are expected to participate in Mass on Sundays, and a Communion Service is NOT a Mass.
- 3. The remainder of Sunday Masses will continue with our regular schedule. We thank the Comboni Missionary priests for covering our 8:00am Spanish Mass. Fr. Bill will cover the Saturday eve Mass and 4 remaining Masses on Sunday. We hope the Archdiocese can send a priest to help, please pray.

## Confessions on Hold for Friday Nights Sept. 8 and Sept. 15

At this time because of our current parish situation we cannot promise that a priest will be available for Friday night confessions on Sept. 8<sup>th</sup> and Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>. **Therefore we deeply regret that confessions for these two nights are canceled.** Please watch the bulletin and our website for any changes.

## Communion Service – Mass – Eucharist – Mass Intentions - Not the Same Thing

A communion service is not the same thing as a Mass. It lacks the fullness of the Eucharist. Without the Mass, there is no Eucharistic Sacrifice, no presence at Calvary. It provides the meal without the banquet of the Lord. It is like a wedding banquet, you are very late and miss the actual banquet but receive something at the door. While it is truly the Body of Christ it is something that remains, is left over, from a Mass celebrated before. And of course this service lacks the opportunity to receive the sacred Blood of Christ which cannot be reserved. The Church wants much more for you.

We are missing something far more important, more beautiful, more wonderful than a wedding. We are missing the opportunity to unite our hearts and souls to the love of Jesus Christ given through his sacrifice on the cross of Calvary; the fullness and completion of the Eucharistic banquet, the Eucharistic sacrifice.

With fewer and aging priests this is already happening in many parts of the United States on a regular basis.

Because there is no Sacrifice of the Mass, Mass intentions cannot be accepted, it is not Mass. Mass intentions already on the calendar will have to be rescheduled. Please consult our parish office if you need help with this.





#### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

#### Love and Truth

I think even the most devout, the most pious Catholic reading this could summon to mind, if asked, one or even two examples of Catholic teaching for which they have desperately looked for a loophole.

Don't worry, I won't make you share with the group. But bring it to your mind now: the doctrine you once resented, or perhaps still do. The commandment you don't fully understand, the one you bristle against. The rule you find the hardest to follow. The belief you hate explaining to your friends.

If it disappeared from scripture or dropped out of the catechism, would your life really be easier? Would you be happier?

I am thinking of mine. For a long time, I searched high and low for a way around this particular teaching. I read books and Scripture and tradition, I prayed and reflected and tried to argue with myself. For a time, I gave up complying with it entirely. I threw it to the wind, with a shoulder shrug and a self-satisfied assurance to myself that God, being a loving father, does not want his child to be unhappy.

But reader: I was miserable. I was so, so miserable, and I stayed that way until I finally accepted that God is, indeed, a loving father, and desires nothing less than the unhappiness of his children. And so, to ward it off, he has given us the truth, and asked us to share it amongst ourselves like a cherished heirloom, a priceless inheritance.

To share truth, you must show love. To show love, you must share truth. One demands the other. Because this is what Christ does for us, and this is the mission of the Church in this world. Loosening and binding. Bearing witness. Giving testimony. Speaking truth, and in speaking truth, showing love.



## **GOSPEL MEDITATION**

What are you supposed to do about the bad behavior of the people around you? You know who I'm talking about. That family member, friend, coworker, or acquaintance who is quite immoral. On this front there are two lively options in our culture: bash the person to others (probably online) or pretend everything's fine. The former damages the person. The latter ignores reality. What to do?

Jesus' strategy in the Gospel of Matthew is as wise as it is difficult: go directly to the person, and then gradually expand the circle of intervention. Simple, often effective, and hard. But what we often miss is the context of the Lord's strategy, "If your brother sins against you..." Notice the italicized words. Is the person in a Christian familial bond with you? And was the action in question against *you*? If so, proceed with the plan. Fine. But how often we fret over the sins of those who either aren't our spiritual siblings or have done nothing directly to us. This is not an invitation to ignore injustice in the world. Rather, we should build bonds of fraternal love, and carefully discern when and how others' sins are indeed our concern. Sometimes they are. Other times — frequently, perhaps — they simply are not.




