Christian Nationalism Is Not Christian

Dear Friends,

I love my Catholic-Christian faith. I have faith in Jesus Christ and love for our Catholic tradition of worship with Mass and seven wonderful sacraments in which Jesus Christ is truly present. I am proud to be a parish priest and your pastor.

Politically speaking I oppose the far-left communists and far-right fascists. I am not registered in either of our two main political parties. My comments in this letter are a profession of faith, a moral statement, not a political one.

There is no such thing as a Christian nation, there are only Christian people. A nation cannot be baptized - only individuals who have made a free choice to accept the profound love of our Lord Jesus Christ. People cannot be forced, required, pressured or manipulated because those very acts are NOT of Jesus Christ who loved tenderly and genuinely respected everyone's freedom. He did not force himself, rather he invited.

It can be easily argued that to be a nation of Christians we must always respect and protect the religious expressions of those who are not Christian. Jesus healed and helped people of every faith. Sometimes with words he invited them to follow, sometimes he invited them through the silence of his heart.

Christian Nationalism Is an Attack on Catholicism

Some of the loudest voices in this movement are now expressing ideas that are anti-Catholic. One leading figure has called for laws prohibiting Catholic processions because he views our statues as offensive. Many of these leaders do not regard Catholics as Christians.

I have great respect for Evangelical Christians, for their commitment and dedication to spreading the Good News. Some nationally known leaders of the Christian Nationalism movement have insulted real Evangelical Christians as they manipulate the message of the Gospels. They have erected a golden statue to a political leader. This past Holy Week they canceled a 60-year custom of Catholic Good Friday services in the Pentagon Chapel; but offered their own.

They have openly attacked our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV proclaiming they know more about our Catholic Just War Doctrine than he does; he who has studied and taught it for over four decades. Their political figures have indicated they know the Scriptures better than Pope Leo, who once again has studied, taught, preached the Word of God for 40+ years.

Christian Nationalism violates our American constitution, insults our Catholic traditions, ignores the Word of God, discredits and insults our neighbors who are not Christian. This crushes my heart.

Please join me in prayer for all women and men of faith, every faith, for the good of our nation.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK ON SATURDAY: July 11, 2026

The faithful who desire to be anointed should attend the 8:15am Mass and immediately after Mass, the sacrament will be administered by one or more of our parish priests. It will follow Mass, with a five minute break, to allow those with other commitments to leave without interrupting the prayer of the sacrament.

WHO CAN BE ANOINTED?

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick --- is for those with a serious or chronic illness, physical, mental or emotional. It is for the baptized and normally for those over the age of reason (age 7) but for good reason young baptized children and infants can be anointed. This is not for the ordinary common illnesses we all get once or twice a year. It is for **SERIOUS** or **CHRONIC** illnesses, such as: heart disease, cancer, arthritis, emphysema, diabetes, physical disability or limitation, etc., etc. By "chronic" we mean a disease that may not be serious at the moment but will steadily grow worse (&/or never get better), such as a child or adult with asthma.

Those about to have **SURGERY** should be anointed. And it is encouraged that those who have reached age 65 be anointed once a year, without regard for medical condition.

HOW OFTEN SHOULD ONE BE ANOINTED?

Those with any serious or chronic illness should be anointed anytime their condition changes significantly. And again the Church lovingly encourages those 65 and over to be anointed once a year. For all others, we would recommend at least quarterly, that is every three months.

El Nacionalismo Cristiano no es Cristiano

Queridos amigos:

Amo mi fe católica cristiana. Tengo fe en Jesucristo y amo nuestra tradición católica de culto, con la Misa y los siete sacramentos maravillosos en los que Jesucristo está verdaderamente presente. Me enorgullece ser párroco y su pastor.

Políticamente hablando, me opongo tanto a los comunistas de extrema izquierda como a los fascistas de extrema derecha. No estoy inscrito en ninguno de los dos partidos políticos principales. Los comentarios de esta carta constituyen una profesión de fe y una declaración moral, no política.

No existe tal cosa como una nación cristiana; solo existen personas cristianas. Una nación no puede ser bautizada; solo pueden serlo los individuos que han elegido libremente aceptar el amor profundo de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. No se puede obligar, exigir, presionar ni manipular a las personas, porque tales actos **NO** provienen de Jesucristo, quien amaba con ternura y respetaba genuinamente la libertad de todos. Él no se imponía; más bien, invitaba.

Se puede afirmar con facilidad que, para ser una nación de cristianos, debemos respetar y proteger siempre las expresiones religiosas de quienes no son cristianos. Jesús sanó y ayudó a personas de todas las creencias. A veces las invitaba a seguirle con palabras; otras veces, lo hacía a través del silencio de su corazón.

El Nacionalismo Cristiano es un Ataque al Catolicismo

Algunas de las voces más estridentes de este movimiento expresan ahora ideas anti-católicas. Una figura destacada ha pedido leyes que prohíban las procesiones católicas, pues considera ofensivas nuestras imágenes religiosas. Muchos de estos líderes no consideran cristianos a los católicos.

Siento un gran respeto por los cristianos evangélicos, por su compromiso y dedicación a la difusión de la Buena Nueva. Algunos líderes de renombre nacional del movimiento nacionalista cristiano han insultado a los verdaderos cristianos evangélicos al manipular el mensaje de los Evangelios. Han erigido una estatua de oro en honor a un líder político. La pasada Semana Santa cancelaron una costumbre de 60 años de celebrar

los oficios católicos del Viernes Santo en la capilla del Pentágono, aunque ofrecieron los suyos propios.

Han atacado abiertamente a nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa, proclamando que saben más sobre nuestra doctrina católica de la “guerra justa” que él, quien la ha estudiado y enseñado durante más de cuatro décadas. Sus figuras políticas han dado a entender que conocen las Escrituras mejor que el Papa León, quien lleva más de 40 años estudiando, enseñando y predicando la Palabra de Dios.

El nacionalismo cristiano viola nuestra Constitución estadounidense, insulta nuestras tradiciones católicas, ignora la Palabra de Dios, y desacredita e insulta a nuestros vecinos que no son cristianos. Esto me parte el corazón.

Por favor, únanse a mí en oración por todas las mujeres y hombres de fe —de cualquier fe— por el bien de nuestra nación.

THE SMALLNESS OF GREAT FAITH

My children attend Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) for their faith formation. Because of its Montessori basis, CGS atriums, which are something like classrooms, contain lots of objects made from real materials — authentic glass, wood, and ceramic.

This is a polite way of saying there are lots of breakable things in there.

So when my four-year-old entered the atrium on her first day of CGS, my whole body tensed, wondering what she would shatter first. I had to restrain myself from crying out, “Don’t touch anything!” She spotted the prayer table — the low, wooden stand which holds an open Bible, candles, a vase with flowers and a statue of the Good Shepherd. It’s the centerpiece of every atrium.

She knelt before the table. She made the sign of the cross. And she sat there, still and silent.

I stopped dead in my tracks. How had she known to come here? And where did she learn to make the sign of the cross? (Obviously we’ve tried to teach her, but she does it wrong every time!) And why was she sitting there so quietly, so expectantly, in front of a book she can’t read?

A thought came to me so clearly: Well, Colleen, you can read that book. But can you understand it?

It is so easy for us to forget that great faith does not require great intelligence. It does not require great knowledge of the world and its workings. Great faith does not require the believer to possess any answers.

Great faith only requires the believer to know his own smallness.

What is grooming?

Child safety experts consider grooming a core component of sexual abuse. Grooming is a manipulative process in which a person who intends harm gains access to a child, often through behaviors that seem innocent, and builds up a relationship that will ultimately allow the predator to abuse the child. Children who are groomed are slowly taught to accept and excuse any behaviors by the predator, because of the relationship that has been built up over time. A predator relies on manipulation to reduce a child's resistance and to maintain secrecy. El depredador recurre a la manipulación para reducir la resistencia del niño y mantener el secreto. MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

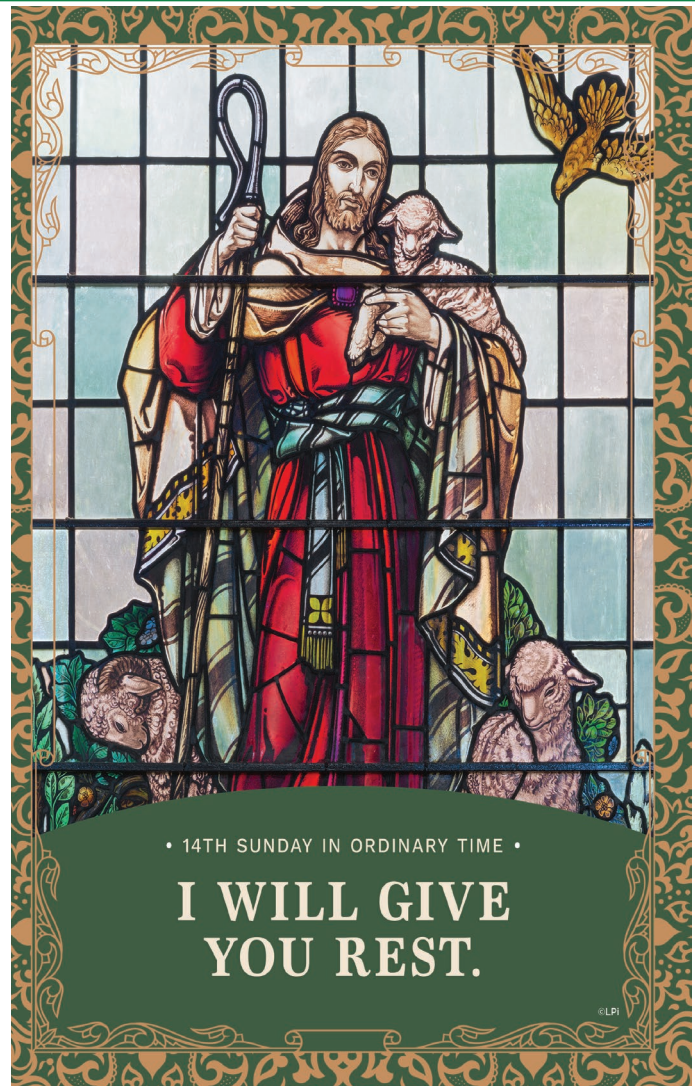

GOSPEL MEDITATION

This weekend, our nation celebrates the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Unlike most nations, the United States was not founded primarily on a shared ethnicity, language, or culture. Instead, our founders built a political community out of diverse peoples united by a shared vision of liberty. That vision echoes something deep in the Christian mystery revealed in today's Gospel.



Jesus returns to his hometown. The people see only what is familiar: the carpenter, the son of Mary, one of their own. As Mark tells us, "They took offense at him. Jesus said, 'A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.'" Their narrow vision blinds them. Jesus has come to inaugurate a new communion that transcends geography, bloodlines, and culture. He has come to unite all people in himself.

At its best, America's national unity reflects this possibility, which fully subsists only in the Catholic Church. Our unity is not based on ancestry or tribe, but on a shared commitment to higher ideals. For this reason, we can love our country with gratitude while situating patriotism within the broader horizon of faith.

Rooted in Christ, we are less vulnerable to the unholy tribalism that threatens civic life and faith. This weekend, let us thank God for our nation and pray that we also live as citizens of Heaven in Jesus Christ.

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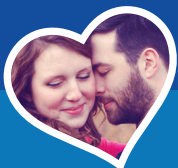
