### Diocese of North Queensland COVID Compliance

Bishop Keith states that we have a moral and legal duty to protect all those who take part in church activities, especially those who are vulnerable, including those who are not vaccinated by necessity or choice.

QLD government rules which now apply, as follows:

- Our usual worship services are classified as "Unrestricted Gatherings" where proof of full-vaccination is **NOT** required.
- Face masks are now **mandatory** in all indoor spaces (except at home), and therefore must be worn here at all times except when taking communion.
- We must continue to practice social distancing (1 person per 2 square metres), and good hand hygiene.

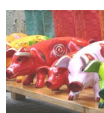
