St. Clare's Home is a maternity home for expectant mothers who choose life and are in need of shelter, safety and security. It is operated under the supervision of our beautiful Sisters of St. Michael the Archangel, plus our many volunteers. We welcome women and children with open arms to a comfortable and caring environment. The demand for the services we provide has skyrocketed since Roe vs. Wade was overturned. The home has experienced full capacity in the last year as we have served more than 42 moms, 18 children and 23 babies born in the home.

St. Clare's Home is located in Greenville County and provides mothers and their babies preand post-natal care. In addition, during their stay at the home, women are provided knowledge for life. Classes include childbirth, parenting, proper nutrition, budgeting and financial planning. Our residents are supported to further their educations and career goals and are offered a mentor to guide them along that path. The focus is on fulfilling our mothers' physical, emotional, educational and spiritual needs to ensure that they are confident to care for their children, manage a household and support themselves financially. Crisis pregnancy centers do incredible work — but pregnant women without stable living conditions need St. Clare's Home.

St. Clare's is a REAL HOME that consists of bedrooms for eight women, a full kitchen, family room, chapel and 15 acres of grounds. We provide 24-hour care and supervision. Your generosity has also helped countless women and children through our outreach centers with clothing, diapers, baby items and furniture. While we are sad to see our moms depart, we are excited to see them launch into their next stages. Using the skill they have gained at St. Clare's, moms have reunited with their families and their baby's fathers, or have chosen to live independently. We keep in touch and are excited when they attend events we host in the home.
