Faith Formation Corner:

It's Thursday, September 9, 2021. The Gospel at morning Mass was from Luke 6:27-38. We all know this Gospel, but do we KNOW this Gospel? This Gospel is where Jesus speaks directly to his disciples (so basically to you, me, us), the Church, the body of Christ. Let me refresh your memory: "Jesus said to his disciples:

"To you who hear I say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. . . . love your enemies and do good to them, and lend expecting nothing back. . . Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven. . . (Luke 6:27-38) I have to ask, are we, as Catholic Christians BEING CHRIST to others? My own answer? I need to go to Confession . . . every day. Why? Because I fail at this . . . so much of the time. Ask my poor husband. (No joke)

I try, I truly try, but gosh, it is hard!!! Ugh. I have been doing more of "do not" than "do." I can do the "lend and expect nothing back," but I must say sometimes I do "expect" something back, not necessarily what I give to someone, but when I need validation, or am in a low spot emotionally, or spiritually, my flesh can scream for attention. Maybe that's the point of being a believer, to not want anything, to be grateful for what is given to us, to be grateful in the giving, to pray blessing onto someone we know is difficult, or who does not like us, or who can make life downright miserable for us. I find it very challenging to "love my enemies," much less "do good to them." I would rather forget them, or deny them. But I KNOW that's not the right way. That isn't the way of LOVE. So, I have decided to force myself to pray for those I identify as my enemies. If Christ was "resolute" about his Passion, Death, and Crucifixion, the least I can do is decide to pray for the people that may hurt me, love them from a distance by praying blessings upon them, wishing them all the wonderful blessing in my life.

This is the stuff that makes me anxious that I may not have enough time on this earth to get this right. Once our time on earth is done, that's it, Purgatory may be our one last ditch to get things we didn't get right here, right there before being allowed to enter the gates of our heavenly home. So while I am grateful that our Catholic faith, in its wisdom, gives us Purgatory, that also means the suffering may not be over. Yuk. Honestly, I admit that I would rather suffer here with everyone else than be suffering in Purgatory (or hopefully not Hell). What if Heaven is not that far off from Purgatory? What if we might be able to see our brothers and sisters praising God, or hear them singing it up in Heaven? That would be torture! Nope, I want Heaven.

However, I must say, that I have come to realize that Jesus literally directs us to behave in the RIGHT way, in order that our hearts remain pure. We cannot be effective evangelizers if our hearts are tainted with negativity. Precisely, this is the struggle of the flesh. Jesus outlines it perfectly for us, in order for us, to keep moving our faith forward. We cannot, must not allow ourselves to be spiritually burdened with such "anti-virtues." We must take on this battle of flesh and spirit, and with Christ, we KNOW our spirit will win, for "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me,"(Philippians 4:13) and "if God is for us, who can be against us?"(Romans 8:31) Our God is so very good, so very kind, so very merciful; I hope I can remember this the next time somebody cuts me off on the freeway. Gospel Reflection:

Mark 8:27-35

Peter declares that Jesus is the Christ, and Jesus teaches that those who would follow him must take up his or her cross.

Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's reading is the turning point in Mark's Gospel. In the presentation of the life and ministry of Jesus found in the Gospel of Mark, the deeds of Jesus have shown Jesus to be the Son of God. Yet many, including Jesus' disciples, have not yet realized his identity. In today's Gospel, Jesus asks the disciples for a field report by asking what others say about him. He then turns the question directly to the disciples and asks what they believe. Peter speaks for all of them when he announces that they believe Jesus to be the Christ.

The word *Christ* is the Greek translation of the Hebrew word for Messiah, which means "the anointed one." At the time of Jesus, the image of the Messiah was laden with popular expectations, most of which looked for a political leader who would free the Jewish people from Roman occupation. Jesus does not appear to have used this term for himself. As we see in today's reading, Jesus refers to

himself instead as the Son of Man, a term derived from the Jewish Scriptures, found in the Book of Daniel and in other apocryphal writings. Many scholars suggest that the phrase Son of Man is best understood to mean "human being."

Now that the disciples have acknowledged Jesus as the Christ, Jesus confides in them the outcome of his ministry: he will be rejected, must suffer and die, and will rise after three days. Peter rejects this prediction, and Jesus rebukes him severely. The image of Christ that Jesus is giving is not the image of the Messiah that Peter was expecting. Jesus then teaches the crowd and the disciples about the path of discipleship: To be Christ's disciple is to follow in the way of the cross.

We can easily miss the fear that Jesus' words must have evoked in his disciples. Death by crucifixion was all too familiar as a method of execution in Roman-occupied territories. It was also an omnipresent danger to the Christian community for whom Mark wrote. The path that Jesus was inviting his disciples to share meant tremendous suffering and death. This is the kind of radical commitment and sacrifice that Jesus calls us to adopt for the sake of the Gospel.

Family Connection

Peter had expectations about what it meant to call Jesus the Messiah, the Christ. Jesus was indeed the Messiah, but his life and death would show a different understanding of what it means to be the Messiah. We, too, have expectations of God and our own ideas about what we think God ought to be doing in our world. Like Peter, however, we may risk limiting our image of God by thinking only in human ways. God's plan is always more that we can ever imagine.

As you gather as a family, talk about what we expect God to be doing in our world and in our family life. Then read today's Gospel, Mark 8:31-35. Why do you think Peter was so upset by what Jesus was saying? Notice how Jesus reprimands Peter. Do we sometimes forget to let God be God for us? That is, do we sometimes get discouraged because God doesn't act in our world in the ways that we expect? Pray together that we will remember that God is always working for the world's salvation in ways that are beyond our imagination. Conclude by praying together today's psalm, Psalm 116.

Let them be filled with patience and joy in your presence as they wait for your healing touch. Please restore your servants to full health, dear Father. Remove all fear and doubt from their hearts by the power of your Holy Spirit, and may you, Lord, be glorified through their life, Amen." *Deja que se llenen de paciencia y alegría en tu presencia mientras esperan tu toque sanador.
