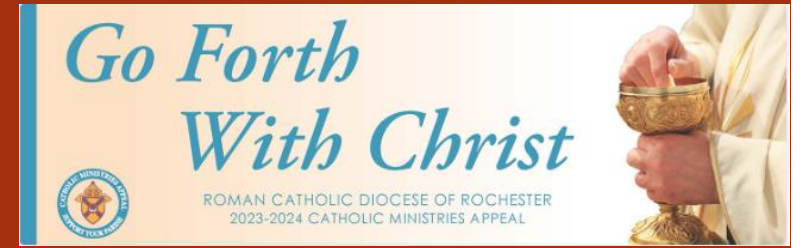

■ Move to 10:30:	50	21.5%
■ Move to 10:00:	48	20.6%
■ No preference:	48	20.6%

Recommendation: Starting Dec 3, 1st Sunday in Advent, move 11:00 to 10:30am at Holy Spirit





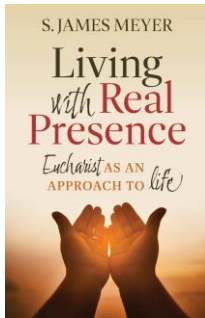
