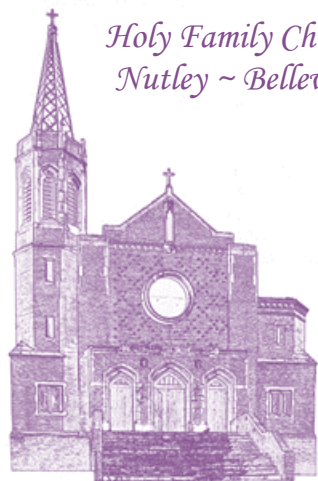


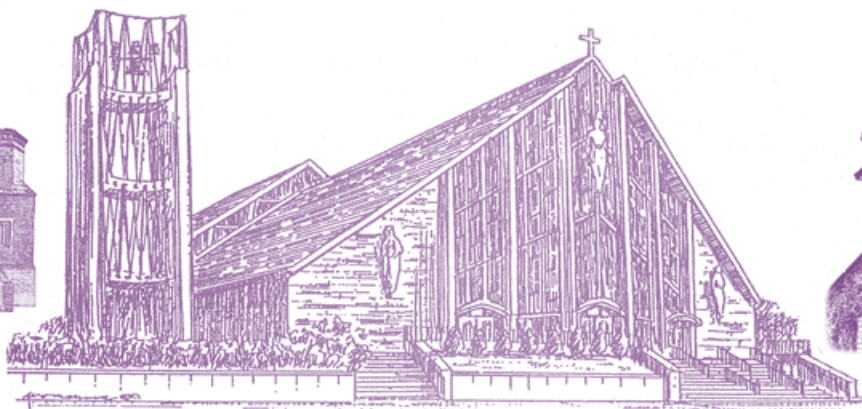

BAPTISM: Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism and should be registered parishioners of Holy Family. Godparents are required to provide verification of Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation.

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

VOCATION: Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

EMERGENCY CALLS: In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-986-1690. The priest on duty will return your call.

ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK - 2021 LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (or Holy Saturday night) as the “paschal fast” to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, **and two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity.**

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

2. The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence “substantially,” or as a whole, is a serious obligation.

3. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

4. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the **First Sunday of Lent, March 4, 2022, to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, June 12, 2022.**

***Canon 920, §1.** *All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year*

MORNING PRAYER: Begin each Lenten day with Morning Prayer in the Chapel at 6:00 A.M. (through April 13)

LENTEN DAILY MASSES: There are 2 daily Masses during Lent: Monday-Friday, 7:00 A.M. in the Chapel; Monday-Saturday, 8:45 A.M. in the Church.

LENTEN Conference: “Spiritual Warfare - Christian Asceticism and Mysticism”: Monday, March 14, 7:00 P.M., in the Church. Speaker: Rev. Frederick L. Miller, S.T.D.

EXPOSITION OF THE EUCHARIST: In the Chapel; every Friday, 9:30 A.M. - 1:30 P.M., Benediction begins at 1:30.

First Friday, April 1, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus until 10:00 PM.

MARIA SS ADDOLORATA MASS

The annual Mass honoring the apparition of Our Lady of Sorrows in Castelpetroso on March 22, 1888, will be celebrated at the 12:00 P.M. Mass on Sunday, March 20, 2022.

FASTING & ALMSGIVING: Operation Rice Bowls, which are distributed in the Church vestibule, help to support Catholic Relief Services care for the poor in developing countries. Please use the calendar and eat a *simpler* meal each week (fasting) and place your sacrifice (alms), the money you save in terms of eating a simpler meal, and return your sacrifice in the envelope provided on Palm Sunday, April 10. “Let us eat simply so that others may simply eat.”

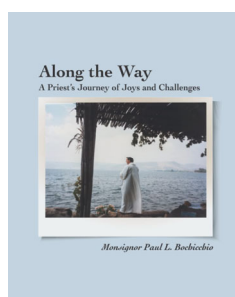

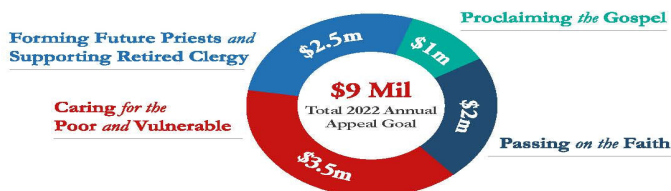

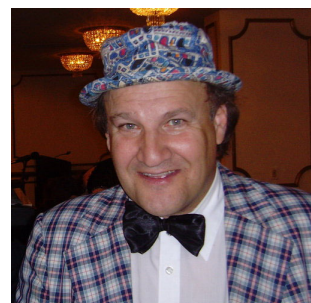

Annual Appeal 2022 UPDATE

As you know, our 2022 Goal for the Annual Appeal is **\$50,480.00**, with a stretch goal of **\$61,351.00**.

To date, our parish totals have reached **\$18,180.00** with a total of 70 donors participating. **\$15,058.33** has been received at the Archdiocese with a balance of **\$3,121.67** from those who have already pledged. The average gift given is **\$259.00**. We have reached 36% of our goal.

In order to reach our stretch goal of **\$61,351.00**, we need **\$46,292.67**. Anything over the stretch goal is returned to the parish. We need pledges in by **June 30, 2022** and paid by **December 2022**.

On a positive note, the parish received a rebate check of **\$11,095.00** for the 2021 AA by exceeding our stretch goal last year. We are using these funds towards the repairs for Holy Family Convent.

Thank you all for your participation. May God Bless you for your love and support of our parish.

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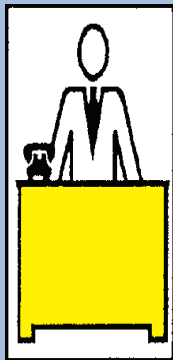


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
