

#### Some Closing Thoughts on Stewardship

I want to begin by thanking all our parishioners these past two months for their wonderful reflections on Stewardship. Stewardship of time, talent, treasure, and prayers is not a matter of quantity but one of quality. What a blessing to have so many of our parishioners who have an exceptional capacity for stewardship! What a blessing to have so many of our members feel at home at St. Peter's!

As I participate in my first stewardship campaign as a priest, I am reminded of a lesson that I learned at my family home. I am reminded of something that my mother taught me when I was a child. She taught me that stewardship is not a one-time act but a deposition of one's spirit, a disposition of generosity. As Christians, we worship a generous God who can never be outdone in his generosity. Our spirit of generosity, therefore, is not something that comes and goes. Rather, it is a fruit of being marked as believers. As we engage in our spiritual development, we notice that there is something inside of us that urges us to give and give generously.

Therefore, our stewardship is not a one-time action but a spiritual discipline. As a spiritual discipline, we must use Gifts of the Holy Spirit such as discernment, fortitude, and piety in our practice of stewardship. We do not have to answer the question of "How?" All we are called to do is surrender ourselves to the movements of the Holy Spirit already at work in our lives. Only then will our stewardship be of the highest quality because our stewardship will be a reflection of the generosity of God.
