

# Liturgical Music Notes October 23 – Ordinary XXX

A text that has inspired many musical settings is that of Psalm 34. This weekend we sing three inspired by these words! Our psalm response is "The Cry of the Poor"; at the Offertory and Communion are two other 20<sup>th</sup> c. compositions based on these beautiful words, but of different musical styles. In contrast, our two hymns trace their roots to 19<sup>th</sup> c. England, with organ prelude and postlude by contemporaries of Handel - Boyce and Stanley – featuring the Trumpet stops of St. Peter's historic Casavant. Our worship has a rich musical palette to choose from!
