### LITURGICAL MUSIC NOTES: First Sunday of Lent

The season of Lent lends itself to musical enrichment: the simplicity of ancient chant complements its austere nature, while organ works by J. S. Bach and other Baroque composers mirror its reflective tone. Solid 17th c. melodies such as *St. Flavian* and *Southwell* support the somber words of "These Forty Days of Lent" and "Have Mercy, Lord, On Us". The latter is a metrical (rhymed) version of Psalm 51, appointed as today's Responsorial, and an example of putting an original Latin text into the language of the people, and in a way they could sing.




**FORMED** is a digital platform with a va-FORMED riety of Catholic movies and programs. Formed is a wonderful resource during

#### **RCIA NEWS**

This Sunday, February 26, during the 11 a.m. Mass, we will celebrate the Rite of Sending with our RCIA candidates and catechumens. Please pray for our them during this holy time of preparation.

What is the RCIA Rite of Sending? Across the entire world, Catholic bishops on the first Sunday of Lent will welcome those sent by the parish to gather together with their godparents and sponsors in what is known as the Rite of Election and the Call to Continuing Conversion. In our Diocese, Bishop David will meet with members of the RCIA groups around the diocese at the Cathedral on Sunday, February 26, and our group from St. Peter is going at 7 p.m. The Rite of Sending offers us as a parish community an opportunity to acknowledge the spiritual progress the catechumens and candidates have made, express our approval, and send them forth to Bishop David with assurance of our care and support.

RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults and is the process for adults from other faith traditions to learn more and/or join the Catholic Church. Catechumens are those preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Candidates are those who were baptized in another faith tradition and are preparing for Confirmation and Eucharist and to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church. 
