This past week we came to the end of the Christmas liturgical season and began Ordinary Time. This is a time in which the grand celebrations of Christmas are done and the regular rhythm of life returns, simpler ordinary days until we begin Lent. When we consider the spiritual life, we can be tempted to think that God only works or manifests himself in big and grand ways, not in the ordinary mundane day to day life. However, it's precisely in the ordinary rhythm of our day to day that God manifests himself most often, we usually call this the small miracles of everyday life. As one Catholic commentator wrote, "Through our daily routine we actually become part of something extraordinary when we unite our lives to Heaven's Almighty. In other words, when we practice the presence of God in all that we do, day in and day out, then everything—no matter how small or ordinary—becomes an offering of faith, hope, and love to God as we partake in our Lord's work of salvation, bringing us and our world closer to Heaven. That's extraordinary!"

La scorsa settimana siamo giunti al termine del tempo liturgico natalizio e abbiamo dato inizio al Tempo Ordinario. Questo è un tempo in cui si concludono le grandi celebrazioni del Natale e ritorna il ritmo regolare della vita, giorni ordinari più semplici fino all'inizio della Quaresima. Quando consideriamo la vita spirituale, possiamo essere tentati di pensare che Dio operi o si manifesti solo in modi grandiosi e grandiosi, non nella normale vita mondana di tutti i giorni. Tuttavia, è proprio nel ritmo ordinario della nostra quotidianità che Dio si manifesta più spesso, di solito li chiamiamo i piccoli miracoli della vita quotidiana. Come ha scritto un commentatore cattolico: "Attraverso la nostra routine quotidiana diventiamo effettivamente parte di qualcosa di straordinario quando uniamo le nostre vite all'Onnipotente del Cielo. In altre parole, quando pratichiamo la presenza di Dio in tutto ciò che facciamo, giorno dopo giorno, allora tutto, non importa quanto piccolo o ordinario, diventa un'offerta di fede, speranza e amore a Dio mentre partecipiamo al nostro L'opera di salvezza del Signore, avvicinando noi e il nostro mondo al Cielo. È straordinario!"

La semana pasada llegamos al final del tiempo litúrgico de Navidad y comenzamos el Tiempo Ordinario. Este es un tiempo en el que se hacen las grandes celebraciones de la Navidad y vuelve el ritmo regular de la vida, días ordinarios más sencillos hasta que comenzamos la Cuaresma. Cuando consideramos la vida espiritual, podemos tener la tentación de pensar que Dios solo obra o se manifiesta a sí mismo en formas grandes y grandiosas, no en la vida mundana ordinaria del día a día. Sin embargo, es precisamente en el ritmo ordinario de nuestro día a día donde Dios se manifiesta con mayor frecuencia, a esto solemos llamarlo los pequeños milagros de la vida cotidiana. Como escribió un comentarista católico: "A través de nuestra rutina diaria, en realidad nos convertimos en parte de algo extraordinario cuando unimos nuestras vidas al Todopoderoso del Cielo. En otras palabras, cuando practicamos la presencia de Dios en todo lo que hacemos, día tras día, entonces todo, sin importar cuán pequeño u ordinario sea, se convierte en una ofrenda de fe, esperanza y amor a Dios a medida que participamos en nuestro la obra de salvación del Señor, acercándonos a nosotros y a nuestro mundo al Cielo. ¡Eso es extraordinario!"
