# Paston's Conner Very Rev. Danny Rodrigues, V.F.

This Sunday we continue to read in our Gospel from the sermon on the mount in St. Matthew's gospel. In this weekend's passage, Jesus tells his disciples and each of us that we are called to be salt of the earth and a light to the world. This passage comes immediately after the Beatitudes and is intimately connected with them. As one commentary put it, "Salt and light are good images for describing those who practice the Beatitudes, that is, those who are disciples of Jesus, and they show the importance of good works. Everyone needs to strive for personal holiness—and for the holiness of others. Jesus uses these two images to illustrate his message." Just as salt gives flavor to food, so too we should give a flavor of the divine in everything we do as Christians. We do this by seeking to live good and holy lives and by fighting against the evil that exists in our world by how we live our lives as followers of Jesus. Just as light illumines the path that we walk in the darkness, we are called to make sure the light of Christ continues to burn brightly to help others to get out of the darkness and walk the path of Christ. This is done by the example we give others and the good works that we perform. May our good God help us with His grace to be salt and light to a world that is flavorless due to sin and in darkness do to selfness and pride.

Questa domenica continuiamo a leggere nel nostro Vangelo dal sermone della montagna nel vangelo di San Matteo. Nel brano di questo fine settimana, Gesù dice ai suoi discepoli e a ciascuno di noi che siamo chiamati ad essere sale della terra e luce per il mondo. Questo brano viene subito dopo le Beatitudini ed è intimamente connesso con esse. Come dice un commento: «Il sale e la luce sono buone immagini per descrivere coloro che praticano le beatitudini, cioè coloro che sono discepoli di Gesù, e mostrano l'importanza delle opere buone. Tutti devono lottare per la santità personale e per la santità degli altri. Gesù usa queste due immagini per illustrare il suo messaggio". Proprio come il sale dà sapore al cibo, così anche noi dovremmo dare un sapore del divino in tutto ciò che facciamo come cristiani. Lo facciamo cercando di vivere una vita buona e santa e combattendo contro il male che esiste nel nostro mondo attraverso il modo in cui viviamo le nostre vite come seguaci di Gesù. Proprio come la luce illumina il sentiero che percorriamo nell'oscurità, siamo chiamati ad assicurarci che la luce di Cristo continui a brillare intensamente per aiutare gli altri a uscire dall'oscurità e percorrere il sentiero di Cristo. Questo si ottiene con l'esempio che diamo agli altri e con le buone opere che compiamo. Possa il nostro buon Dio aiutarci con la sua grazia ad essere sale e luce per un mondo che è insapore a causa del peccato e nelle tenebre fare all'egoismo e all'orgoglio.

Este domingo continuamos leyendo en nuestro Evangelio del sermón de la montaña en el evangelio de San Mateo. En el pasaje de este fin de semana, Jesús les dice a sus discípulos y a cada uno de nosotros que estamos llamados a ser sal de la tierra y luz del mundo. Este pasaje viene inmediatamente después de las Bienaventuranzas y está íntimamente relacionado con ellas. Como lo expresó un comentario: "La sal y la luz son buenas imágenes para describir a los que practican las Bienaventuranzas, es decir, a los que son discípulos de Jesús, y muestran la importancia de las buenas obras. Todos deben luchar por la santidad personal y por la santidad de los demás. Jesús usa estas dos imágenes para ilustrar su mensaje". Así como la sal le da sabor a la comida, también debemos darle un sabor divino a todo lo que hacemos como cristianos. Hacemos esto buscando vivir vidas buenas y santas y luchando contra el mal que existe en nuestro mundo por la forma en que vivimos nuestras vidas como seguidores de Jesús. Así como la luz ilumina el camino que recorremos en la oscuridad, estamos llamados a asegurarnos de que la luz de Cristo continúe brillando intensamente para ayudar a otros a salir de la oscuridad y caminar por el camino de Cristo. Esto se hace con el ejemplo que damos a los demás y las buenas obras que realizamos. Que nuestro buen Dios nos ayude con su gracia a ser sal y luz a un mundo insípido por el pecado y en tinieblas por el egoísmo y el orgullo.
