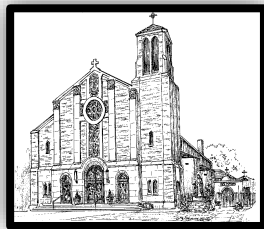

# Pastor's Corner

**Very Rev. Danny Rodrigues, V.F.**

There is a very old saying in Portuguese that is often incorporated in songs dedicated to mothers, "Whoever has a mother has everything, whoever doesn't, has nothing." This speaks to the heart of what a mother means to a child, the great treasure she is in the heart of her children. This Sunday we celebrate in this nation the great gift of motherhood. Motherhood, no matter how it happens, is a great gift from God to women. Throughout Sacred Scripture we read how mothers played an important role in the lives of their children. Mothers like Rebeka, the wife of Isaac, who not only was blessed with children but played an important role in their lives. Mothers who had to make great sacrifices to save the lives of their children, like Jochebed the mother of Moses, who sent her son in a basket on the river in order to save his life. Mothers who helped their sons to be great rulers like Bathsheba the wife of David and mother of Solomon. Of course, we have the greatest of all examples of motherhood in the person of our Blessed Mother, Mary. She is an example to all mothers, a mother all mothers should try to emulate. We pray that God may bless all our mothers on this day and every day and may give eternal rest to those who have already passed from this life to the next.

È un esempio per tutte le madri, una madre che tutte le madri dovrebbero cercare di emulare. Preghiamo affinché Dio benedica tutte le nostre madri in questo giorno e ogni giorno e dia il riposo eterno a coloro che sono già passati da questa vita all'altra.

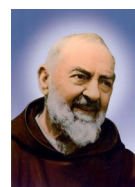

Urgent calls will be attended at any time of day or night. In other cases of illnesses, prolonged or extended, please notify the Parish Office.

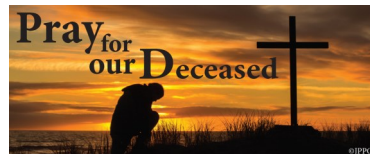
