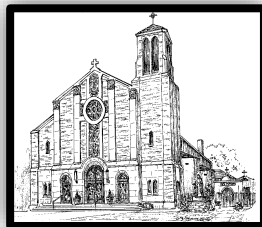

Pastor's Corner

This Sunday we celebrate the great solemnity of Pentecost, the event that began the missionary mission of the Church. On this day, 50 days after the resurrection, the Holy Spirit in the form of tongues of fire came down upon the Blessed Mother and the apostles. The Holy Spirit has always been at work in the world and in the lives of people, we find many references in the Old Testament to the third Person of the Trinity, but with Pentecost the Holy Spirit has come down to stay in the souls of the faithful. Through Baptism and especially at Confirmation, we receive the Holy Spirit who, from then on, dwells in our souls. We receive the gift of the Holy Spirit in order to continue to spread the Good News of the Gospel. Commenting on this reality, Pope Paul VI stated, "Today, as you know, the Church was fully born, through the breath of Christ, the Holy Spirit; and in the Church was born the Word, the witness to and promulgation of salvation in the risen Jesus; and in him who listens to this promulgation is born faith, and with faith a new life, an awareness of the Christian vocation and the ability to hear that calling and to follow it by living a genuinely human life, indeed a life which is not only human but holy. And to make this divine intervention effective, today was born the apostolate, the priesthood, the ministry of the Spirit, the calling to unity, fraternity and peace."

Questa domenica celebriamo la grande solennità della Pentecoste, l'evento che ha dato inizio alla missione missionaria della Chiesa. In questo giorno, 50 giorni dopo la risurrezione, lo Spirito Santo sotto forma di lingue di fuoco scese sulla Beata Madre e sugli apostoli. Lo Spirito Santo è sempre stato all'opera nel mondo e nella vita delle persone, troviamo molti riferimenti nell'Antico Testamento alla terza Persona della Trinità, ma con la Pentecoste lo Spirito Santo è sceso per dimorare nelle anime dei fedeli. Attraverso il Battesimo e specialmente nella Cresima, riceviamo lo Spirito Santo che, da quel momento in poi, abita nelle nostre anime. Riceviamo il dono dello Spirito Santo per continuare a diffondere la Buona Novella del Vangelo. Commentando questa realtà, Papa Paolo VI ha affermato: "Oggi, come sapete, la Chiesa è nata pienamente, per opera del soffio di Cristo, Spirito Santo; e nella Chiesa è nata la Parola, testimonianza e promulgazione della salvezza in Gesù risorto; e in chi ascolta questa promulgazione nasce la fede, e con la fede una vita nuova, la coscienza della vocazione cristiana e la capacità di ascoltare quella chiamata e di seguirla vivendo una vita autenticamente umana, anzi una vita che non è solo umano ma santo. E per rendere efficace questo intervento divino, oggi è nato l'apostolato, il sacerdozio, il ministero dello Spirito, la chiamata all'unità, alla fraternità e alla pace".

Este domingo celebramos la gran solemnidad de Pentecostés, el acontecimiento que dio inicio a la misión misionera de la Iglesia. En este día, 50 días después de la resurrección, el Espíritu Santo en forma de lenguas de fuego descendió sobre la Santísima Madre y los apóstoles. El Espíritu Santo siempre ha estado obrando en el mundo y en la vida de las personas, encontramos muchas referencias en el Antiguo Testamento a la tercera Persona de la Trinidad, pero con Pentecostés el Espíritu Santo ha descendido para quedarse en las almas de los fieles. Por el Bautismo y especialmente en la Confirmación, recibimos el Espíritu Santo que, desde entonces, habita en nuestras almas. Recibimos el don del Espíritu Santo para seguir difundiendo la Buena Nueva del Evangelio. Comentando esta realidad, el Papa Pablo VI afirmó: "Hoy, como sabéis, la Iglesia ha nacido plenamente, por el sopro de Cristo, el Espíritu Santo; y en la Iglesia nació la Palabra, testimonio y promulgación de la salvación en Jesús resucitado; y en quien escucha esta proclamación nace la fe, y con la fe una vida nueva, la conciencia de la vocación cristiana y la capacidad de escuchar esa llamada y de seguirla viviendo una vida genuinamente humana, es decir, una vida que no es sólo humano pero santo. Y para hacer efectiva esta intervención divina ha nacido hoy el apostolado, el sacerdocio, el ministerio del Espíritu, la llamada a la unidad, a la fraternidad y a la paz".

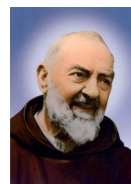

Reading II: I Corinthians 12: 3b-7, 12-13

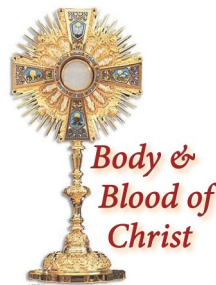

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

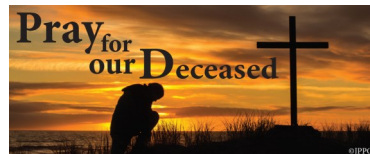


Urgent calls will be attended at any time of day or night. In other cases of illnesses, prolonged or extended, please notify the Parish Office.
