In this Sunday's gospel, Jesus continues to compare the Kingdom of Heaven to several things, one of those things in the pearl of great price. Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger, before he became Pope Benedict XVI, wrote a beautiful reflection of the pearl of great price. He said, "All of the "truths of faith" are explications of the one truth that we discover in them. And this one truth is the pearl of great price that is worth staking our lives: God. He alone can be the pearl for which we give everything else. Dios solo basta ("God alone suffices")—he who finds God has found all things. But we can find him only because he first sought and found us. He is the one who acts first, and for this reason faith in God is inseparable from the mystery of the Incarnation, of the Church and of the sacraments. Everything that is said in the Catechism is an unfolding of the one truth that is God himself—the "love that moves the sun and all the stars." May we too, be able to recognize God as our pearl of great price, and may we cherish him and thank him for all that he does for us, in us and through us.

Nel vangelo di questa domenica, Gesù continua a paragonare il Regno dei Cieli a diverse cose, una di quelle cose nella perla di gran prezzo. Il cardinale Joseph Ratzinger, prima di diventare papa Benedetto XVI, ha scritto una bellissima riflessione sulla perla di grande valore. Disse: "Tutte le "verità di fede" sono implicazioni dell'unica verità che scopriamo in esse. E questa verità è la perla di grande valore su cui vale la pena mettere in gioco la nostra vita: Dio. Lui solo può essere la perla per la quale diamo tutto il resto. Dios solo basta: chi trova Dio ha trovato tutte le cose. Ma possiamo trovarlo solo perché lui per primo ci ha cercato e trovato. È Lui che agisce per primo, e per questo la fede in Dio è inseparabile dal mistero dell'Incarnazione, della Chiesa e dei sacramenti. Tutto ciò che viene detto nel Catechismo è un dispiegarsi dell'unica verità che è Dio stesso: "l'amore che muove il sole e tutte le stelle". Possa anche noi riconoscere Dio come nostra perla preziosa, custodire e ringraziarlo per quanto fa per noi, in noi e attraverso di noi.

En el evangelio de este domingo, Jesús sigue comparando el Reino de los Cielos con varias cosas, una de esas cosas es la perla de gran precio. El cardenal Joseph Ratzinger, antes de convertirse en Papa Benedicto XVI, escribió una hermosa reflexión sobre la perla de gran precio. Él dijo: "Todas las 'verdades de fe' son explicaciones de la única verdad que descubrimos en ellas. Y esta única verdad es la perla de gran precio por la que vale la pena apostar nuestra vida: Dios. Sólo Él puede ser la perla por la que damos todo lo demás. Dios sólo basta : el que encuentra a Dios ha encontrado todas las cosas. Pero podemos encontrarlo solo porque primero nos buscó y nos encontró. Él es quien actúa primero, y por eso la fe en Dios es inseparable del misterio de la Encarnación, de la Iglesia y de los sacramentos. Todo lo que se dice en el Catecismo es un despliegue de la única verdad que es Dios mismo: el "amor que mueve el sol y todas las estrellas". Que también nosotros seamos capaces de reconocer a Dios como nuestra perla preciosa, que lo mimemos y le demos gracias por todo lo que hace por nosotros, en nosotros y a través de nosotros.
