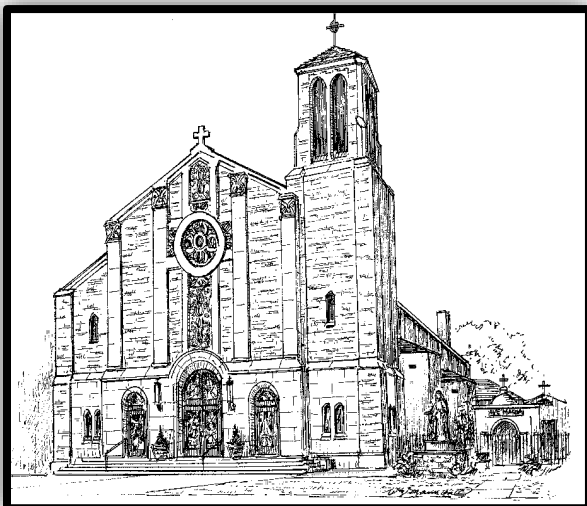

Pastor's Corner

Very Rev. Danny S. Rodrigues, V.F.

This Sunday's liturgy suggests a reflection on our responsibility towards the brothers and sisters around us. It clearly states that no one can remain indifferent in the face of what threatens the life and happiness of a brother or sister and that we are all responsible for one another. The first reading tells us of the prophet as a "watchman", whom God placed to watch over the city of men. Attentive to God's projects and the reality of the world, the prophet realizes what is subverting God's plans and preventing human happiness. As a responsible sentinel, then, it alerts the community to the dangers that threaten it. The Gospel makes clear our responsibility to help each brother to become aware of his mistakes. It is a duty that results from the commandment of love. Jesus teaches, however, that the correct way to reach this goal does not pass through humiliation or condemnation of those who failed, but through fraternal, loyal, friendly dialogue, which reveals to the brother that our intervention results from love.

La liturgia di questa domenica suggerisce una riflessione sulla nostra responsabilità verso i fratelli e le sorelle che ci circondano. Afferma chiaramente che nessuno può rimanere indifferente di fronte a ciò che minaccia la vita e la felicità di un fratello e che tutti siamo responsabili gli uni degli altri. La prima lettura ci parla del profeta come di una "sentinella", che Dio ha posto a vigilare sulla città degli uomini. Attento ai progetti di Dio e alla realtà del mondo, il profeta si rende conto di ciò che sovverte i disegni di Dio e impedisce la felicità umana. Come sentinella responsabile, quindi, avverte la comunità dei pericoli che la minacciano. Il Vangelo chiarisce la nostra responsabilità di aiutare ogni fratello a prendere coscienza dei propri errori. È un dovere che deriva dal comandamento dell'amore. Gesù insegna, però, che la strada corretta per raggiungere questo traguardo non passa attraverso l'umiliazione o la condanna di chi ha fallito, ma attraverso il dialogo fraterno, leale, amichevole, che rivela al fratello che il nostro intervento è frutto dell'amore.

La liturgia de este domingo sugiere una reflexión sobre nuestra responsabilidad hacia los hermanos y hermanas que nos rodean. Dice claramente que nadie puede permanecer indiferente ante lo que amenaza la vida y la felicidad de un hermano o hermana y que todos somos responsables unos de otros. La primera lectura nos habla del profeta como un "atalaya", a quien Dios puso para vigilar la ciudad de los hombres. Atento a los proyectos de Dios y a la realidad del mundo, el profeta se da cuenta de lo que está subvirtiendo los planes de Dios e impidiendo la felicidad humana. Entonces, como centinela responsable, alerta a la comunidad sobre los peligros que la amenazan. El Evangelio deja clara nuestra responsabilidad de ayudar a cada hermano a tomar conciencia de sus errores. Es un deber que resulta del mandamiento del amor. Jesús enseña, sin embargo, que el camino correcto para alcanzar esta meta no pasa por la humillación o la condena de los que fracasaron, sino por el diálogo fraterno, leal y amistoso, que revele al hermano que nuestra intervención resulta del amor.
