Pastor's Corner Very Rev. Danny S. Rodrigues, V.F.

In this weekend's gospel we have our Lord deliver his sermon on the Beatitudes. Unlike St. Matthew's version that lists the eight beatitudes, in St. Luke's version the Lord gives four beatitudes and four "woes," the antithesis of a beatitude. Both versions should provide for us comfort in the spiritual life at the same time that St. Luke's version also reminds us of what is most important. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church states, "the beatitude we are promised confronts us with decisive moral choices. It invites us to purify our hearts of bad instincts and to seek the love of God above all else. It teaches us that true happiness is not found in riches or well-being, in human fame or power, or in any human achievement—however beneficial it may be—such as science, technology, and art, or indeed in any creature, but in God alone, the source of every good and of all love." The beatitudes are a reminder that God never abandons us, that we can trust in his Divine Providence even if at times he seems far. The "woes" that he proclaims are also a reminder for us to not worry about the things of this world that in the end have no lasting value especially for our souls.

Nel vangelo di questo fine settimana abbiamo il nostro Signore che pronuncia il suo sermone sulle Beatitudini. A differenza della versione di San Matteo che elenca le otto beatitudini, nella versione di San Luca il Signore dà quattro beatitudini e quattro "guai", l'antitesi di una beatitudine. Entrambe le versioni dovrebbero darci conforto nella vita spirituale e allo stesso tempo la versione di San Luca ci ricorda ciò che è più importante. Come afferma il Catechismo della Chiesa Cattolica, «la beatitudine che ci è promessa ci mette di fronte a scelte morali decisive. Ci invita a purificare il nostro cuore dai cattivi istinti e a cercare l'amore di Dio sopra ogni altra cosa. Ci insegna che la vera felicità non si trova nella ricchezza o nel benessere, nella fama o nel potere dell'uomo, o in qualsiasi conquista umana – per quanto benefica possa essere – come la scienza, la tecnologia e l'arte, o addirittura in qualsiasi creatura, ma solo in Dio, fonte di ogni bene e di ogni amore". Le beatitudini ci ricordano che Dio non ci abbandona mai, che possiamo confidare nella sua Divina Provvidenza anche se a volte sembra lontana. I "guai" che egli proclama ci ricordano anche di non preoccuparci delle cose di questo mondo che alla fine non hanno alcun valore duraturo soprattutto per la nostra anima.

En el evangelio de este fin de semana tenemos a nuestro Señor pronunciando su sermón sobre las Bienaventuranzas. A diferencia de la versión de San Mateo que enumera las 8 bienaventuranzas, en la versión de San Lucas el Señor da cuatro bienaventuranzas y cuatro "ayes", la antítesis de una bienaventuranza. Ambas versiones deberían brindarnos consuelo en la vida espiritual, al mismo tiempo que la versión de San Lucas también nos recuerda lo que es más importante. Como dice el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, "la bienaventuranza que se nos promete nos enfrenta a decisiones morales decisivas. Nos invita a purificar nuestro corazón de malos instintos y a buscar el amor de Dios por encima de todo. Nos enseña que la verdadera felicidad no se encuentra en las riquezas o el bienestar, en la fama o el poder



humanos, ni en ningún logro humano, por beneficioso que sea, como la ciencia, la tecnología y el arte, ni siquiera en ninguna criatura, sino sólo en Dios, fuente de todo bien y de todo amor. Las bienaventuranzas son un recordatorio de que Dios nunca nos abandona, que podemos confiar en su Divina Providencia aunque a veces parezca lejana. Los "ayes" que él proclama son también un recordatorio para que no nos preocupemos por las cosas de este mundo que al final no tienen ningún valor duradero, especialmente para nuestras almas.

Reading I: Jeremiah 17: 5-8

The prophet contrasts the wicked of Judah, who resemble a desert shrub, with the righteous, who are like a thriving fruit tree drawing life from a nearby stream.

Reading II: I Corinthians 15: 12, 16-20

Corinthian skepticism about Christ's resurrection and the future of our bodies led to a decline of morality among the community. Paul teaches the truth of the resurrection and our true destiny of life eternal.

The Gospel: Luke 6: 17, 20-26

Here is "The Sermon on the Plain," much like Matthew's "Sermon on the Mount." (Mt. 5-7) Jesus envisions the negative conditions of this life being overturned in the next. The blessed will experience lasting peace.

PARISH REGISTRATION—Every Catholic should be registered in a parish. To become a registered member of our Parish Family stop by or call the parish office. Forms can be found in the vestibule of church. Letters for suitability for Godparents and sponsors are given only to those who are registered, attend mass regularly and contribute to the good of the parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY—Arrangements are to be made at least one year in advance and before you book your venue. Couples are required to attend the Archdiocese marriage prep sessions.

BAPTISMS—are celebrated on the third Sunday of each month in English and the first and third Saturday of the month in Spanish. We ask that you please contact the rectory to register your child at least 1 month in advance. Godparents will need to show proof of Confirmation and be active in practicing their faith in their parishes. Only 3 children will be registered each date. Children 7 years of age and older, must first attend Religious Education classes before Baptism.
