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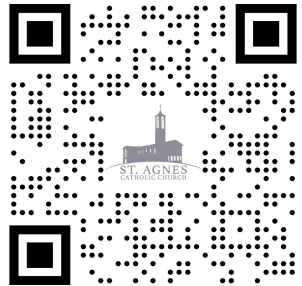

<u>Baptisms</u> Baptisms are celebrated on the 2nd Saturday of every month at 1pm in English. <u>REQUIREMENTS TO BAPTIZE</u> • Child must be under 7 years of age. • Celebration: 2nd Saturday of every month at 1pm. • Parents must submit a copy of the baby's birth or hospital certificate AND provide a copy of Godparents IDs at check-in plus \$ 50 donation. → Godparents, if they are a couple, must be married in the Church & have completed their sacraments. → If they are single, they must have all sacraments: Baptism, 1st Communion, and Confirmation. → Mandatory Completion of Pre-Baptismal Class for Parents and Godparents on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month. Gospel Reflection

Our first reading from the Book of Genesis takes us to the fall of Adam and Eve. There is no need for us to go into the nature of the sin only that they had disobeyed God. They were forbidden from eating from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Gn. 2:16-17). Instead of God accusing them of their sinfulness, He asks them, “Where are you?” Adam then responds to God saying that he was afraid and naked, so he hid himself (Gn. 3:10). In one sentence, Adam expressed fear, shame, defensiveness, self-pity, but he did not say sorry for what he has done. As a matter of fact, he begins to blame Eve for his sin.

It is clear from this text that God is inviting Adam to confess his sins. Rather than taking responsibility for what he has done, Adam blames God and Eve: “You gave me this woman and she gave me the fruit!”

How often is that the story of our lives, we blame others for our sinfulness? Instead of taking responsibility for actions, we shift the blame onto others and even God. The reality is that our Lord wants to forgive us. But we must take ownership that our sin damages our relationship with God who is worthy of all our love.

Jesus in the Gospel talks to us about the unforgivable sin (blaspheming against the Holy Spirit). What is that? The Catechism tells us, “There are no limits to the mercy of God, but anyone who deliberately refuses to accept His mercy by repenting, rejects the forgiveness of his sins and the salvation offered by the Holy Spirit” (CCC 1864). In other words, the only sin God won’t forgive us of is the sin that we don’t allow Him to forgive because we, like the devil, seek to hold on to our sin rather than letting Him away our sins.
