He calls us to deep water as well, to the depths of our faith, to the depths of our being. It can be as scary as the deep end of a pool when you are learning to swim. But we have Jesus' words to assure us: "Do not be afraid" (Luke 5:10). Even far from shore, let us respond as Isaiah did: "Here I am!" (Isaiah 6:8).


