Breaking Open God's Word: Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Note also the way Jesus counsels us to handle the faults in others. We're not told to condemn our brother or accuse our sister. No, we're called to kindly help them. Then both you and them will be better.

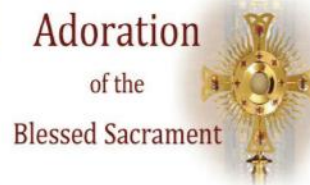
