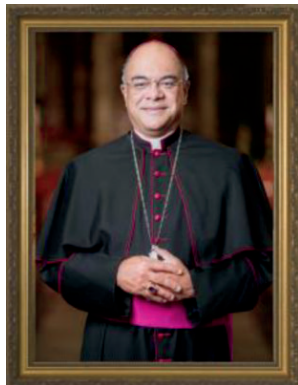

Breaking Open God's Word: Fifth Sunday of Easter
