At the Last Supper, he allowed his Body to be broken and his Blood to be poured out and gave himself to his disciples. Doing the same on the cross, he gave himself to us all. Throughout his ministry, he modeled for his disciples what he asked them to do: preach repentance, heal the sick, call disciples. Then at the Last Supper, he modeled the sacrifice he would make on the cross. As his disciples now, our lives are the gifts from God that we sacrifice, allowing ourselves to be offered, even broken, for others.


