

"You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." Matthew 16:18

The keys to the Kingdom were given to Peter and so too they are entrusted to us. Stewardship entails total commitment to the Lord and complete trust in His goodness, not a nervous looking over our shoulders to see if we can afford this commitment.

### Breaking Open God's Word: Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

The power that Saints Peter and Paul invoke is not from human or societal sources. Note that Peter begins addressing the lame man with the admission that he has neither silver nor gold. A donor willing to give the man a lot of silver or gold would certainly make the lame man much better off. He would no longer have to beg outside the temple. He would be able to find a decent place to live, hire servants to do what he couldn't, and live comfortably the rest of his years. But Peter's power comes from Jesus Christ. It is even stronger, for now the man is healed, is allowed to enter the temple, and will be able to live his life without being dependent on others' generosity. It is ironic that he invokes "the name of Jesus Christ," the very name he had denied three times. (Acts 3:6). Paul too asserts that the Good News he preaches is of divine, not human, origin. He did not meet with the apostles and learn talking points. No, the truth was revealed directly to him by Christ via a revelation. In the instances we hear today, it is then up to the people of Galatia and the lame man to accept the faith being revealed to them through these saints.


