

The parable of the unjust steward is not about thievery, but about initiative. If Jesus' disciples would be only half as clever at promoting the Kingdom as the unjust manager was at promoting his own self interest, the Kingdom would flourish.

#### Breaking Open God's Word: Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus' parable of the dishonest steward is not as clear. Should the steward be applauded for his ingenuity and prudence? Or scorned for his dishonesty and self-centeredness? Perhaps Jesus is pointing to the steward's shrewdness in planning ahead for his expected fate of poverty and using that to encourage his disciples—the "children of light" (Luke 16:8)—to be as enterprising in pursuing the kingdom. After all, for this future we too are undeserving and dependent on the mercy of others—in this case, God.
