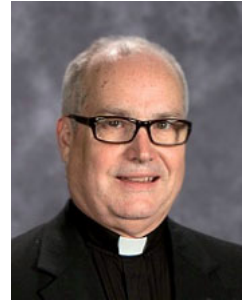

Fasting and Abstinence

Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from eating meat this (Good) Friday, in addition to Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 (inclusive) are required to fast on Good Friday in addition to Ash Wednesday. On these days one full meal is allowed. Food may be taken at two other times during the day, in order to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. Liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed.

Each weekday of Lent is an obligatory day of penance to be marked by prayer and increased devotion to spiritual practices. Some recommendations are daily Mass, Adoration, increased personal prayer time or spiritual study, self-imposed fasting or abstinence, works of charity, almsgiving, Stations of the Cross, the Rosary, retreats, and especially the sacrament of Reconciliation.
