





PASTORAL CARE

FORMATION

2023-24 Elementary FF Registration Open

Registration is now open for Faith Formation at Nativity of Our Lord's 2023-24 year for Grades 1-8. Classes are Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8pm in Nativity School beginning Wednesday, September 20, 2023. Registration is \$60 per student, or \$100 for students receiving First Communion or Confirmation preparation. Family fees cap out at \$200 when registering multiple children, and further financial assistance is available.

Students are taught about Jesus' deep, abiding love for each of them, and how he is working in their lives, through classes, activities, family participation (including family liturgies), and more! Faith Formation tutoring is available for students with special needs, as well as for homeschooled students. Additionally, Faith Formation classes are available to students in grades 1-12 wanting to receive Baptism, First Communion, and/or Confirmation.

Lenten and Good Friday Disciplines

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 (inclusive) are required to fast on Good Friday in addition to Ash Wednesday. On these days one full meal is allowed. Food may be taken at two other times during the day, in order to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. Liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. Catholics 14 years of age and older must also abstain from eating meat this (Good) Friday in addition to Ash Wednesday and Lenten Fridays.

Each weekday of Lent (with the exception of solemnities, including St. Joseph Day and the Annunciation) is an obligatory day of penance to be marked by prayer and increased devotion to spiritual practices. Some recommendations are daily Mass, Adoration, increased personal prayer time or spiritual study, self-imposed fasting or abstinence, works of charity, almsgiving, Stations of the Cross, the Rosary (M-W this week after morning Mass), retreats, and especially the sacrament of Reconciliation. Divine Mercy Novena on Zoom | April 7-15 New Life at Nativity of Our Lord is sponsoring a Divine Mercy Novena for the parish beginning this (Good) Friday, April 7. You are invited to pray with other parishioners via Zoom beginning Easter Monday, April 10, at 8pm. Due to the Triduum and Easter services, we will pray the Novena on our own on Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. 
