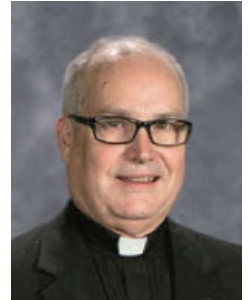

## 2023-24 Elementary FF Registration Open

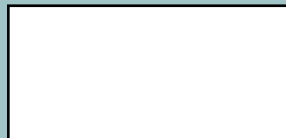
