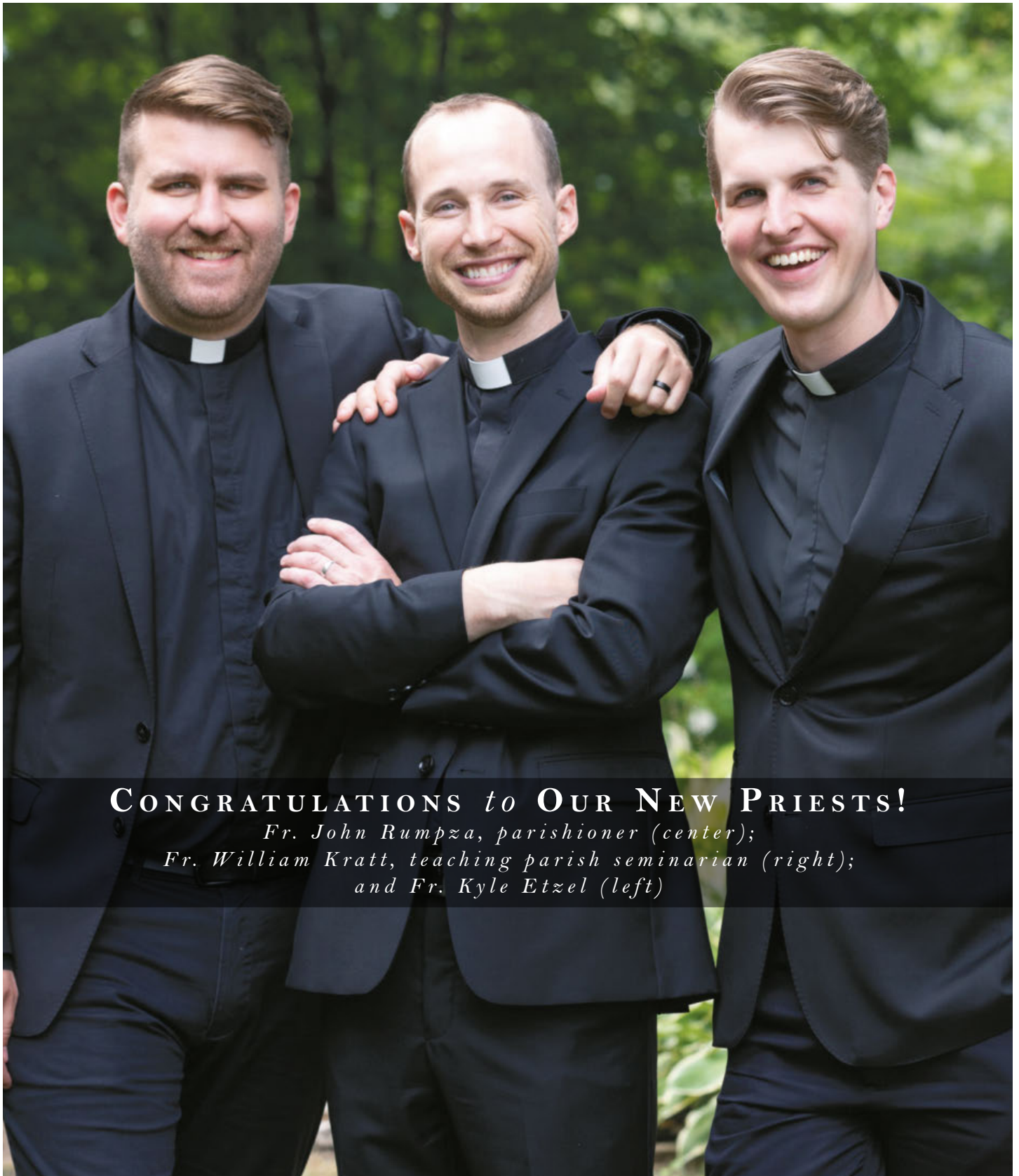

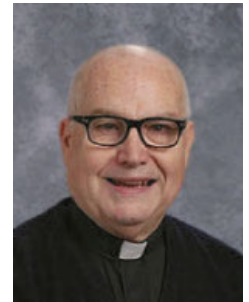

CAMPAIGN CORNER

Construction Update

Scaffolding tear-down is set to begin Monday, June 12, and all of the scaffolding will be removed, except what's in the sanctuary and in the west side of the choir loft. On or around that same time, Gaytee-Palmer will reinstall the stained glass in those areas. When that's finished, they will begin the re-installation of the rest of the windows using scissors lifts.



Beginning Monday, July 10 we hope to begin removing the remaining scaffolding. Re-installation of the pews will begin as the window install allows, with the goal to have the entire project wrapped up by end of July 2023.

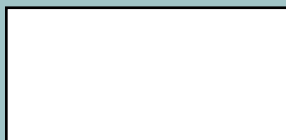


