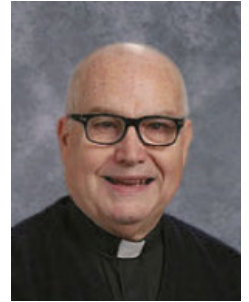

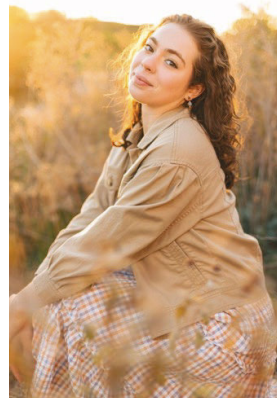
2023 NCCW Spirit of Mary Award Nominees

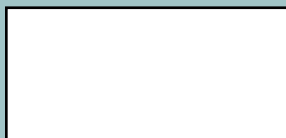


