

RESPECT LIFE

40 Days for Life | Now through November 5 (update) Thank you to all who attended the 40 Days for Life Kick-Off! This worldwide campaign is a determined, peaceful approach, addressing the tragedy of abortion through prayer, fasting, and community outreach. We are joining with neighboring parishes and welcome everyone to join us in this important effort.

Our adopted days for a daily prayer vigil at Planned Parenthood in St. Paul are Monday, October 16 — the feast of St. Gerard Majella — and Wednesday, November 1 — All Saints Day — both from 7am-6pm. Our goal is to have at least two dedicated prayer volunteers per hour at Planned Parenthood on these days, peacefully praying for all who enter and exit there. We also invite you and your family and friends to a clergy-led prayer vigil there on Sunday, October 22 at 1pm — the feast day of Pope St. John Paul II — and encourage everyone to go and pray there as often as you are able during the campaign, now through November 5.

The Harvest is Abundant




