FROM THE PASTOR

Celebrate the Resurrected “God With Us” (*new*)

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

He is risen! Alleluia!

What a joy it is to celebrate Easter with all of you here at Nativity of Our Lord. God is indeed with us — God’s only Son, risen from the dead, is with us. We receive him in the Eucharist at Mass and we worship him in the Blessed Sacrament in the Adoration Chapel. And as our mission and vision declares, that’s something to celebrate!

With that in mind, I have a challenge to offer. Perhaps you received an ashen cross on your forehead six weeks ago, and somebody noticed it — maybe even asked you about it. Perhaps one of your Lenten disciplines, like giving up sweets or swearing or meat on Fridays, was noticed by somebody, and maybe even led to a conversation.

First of all, thanks be to God that you were able to be a witness to others!

But second of all, and here’s my challenge: let’s make our celebration of Easter be so joyful — and so obvious — that other people notice. And if it’s harder to imagine somebody else noticing our Easter celebrations than our Lenten disciplines, then that might be all the more reason to do something about it.

Let us all then, together, invite God to truly change us this Easter day (all eight days of it!) and Easter season (all fifty days!) by way of an outpouring of Easter grace into our hearts — so much so that we’ll want to tell others all about it. That is, if they can’t already tell by themselves...

He is risen! Alleluia!

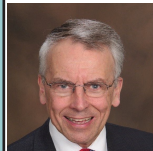
