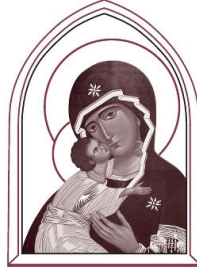

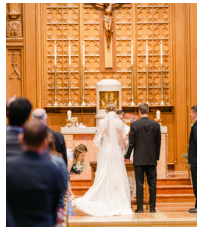
Preparation and Scheduling

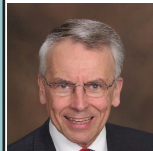
