- Work continues on forgiveness of PPP loan, likely will be 100% forgiven
- Nativity may qualify for the PPP2 loan
- Catholic Finance Corp. will be consulting with the council

- stewardship/development Joyce Kotta is working on updates via email
- Enrollment will be automated online
- Need for continued help with finding how we can help others (such as staff liaisons, family, etc.)

- Will work to get charters on the shared drive so they can be tweaked as we move along
