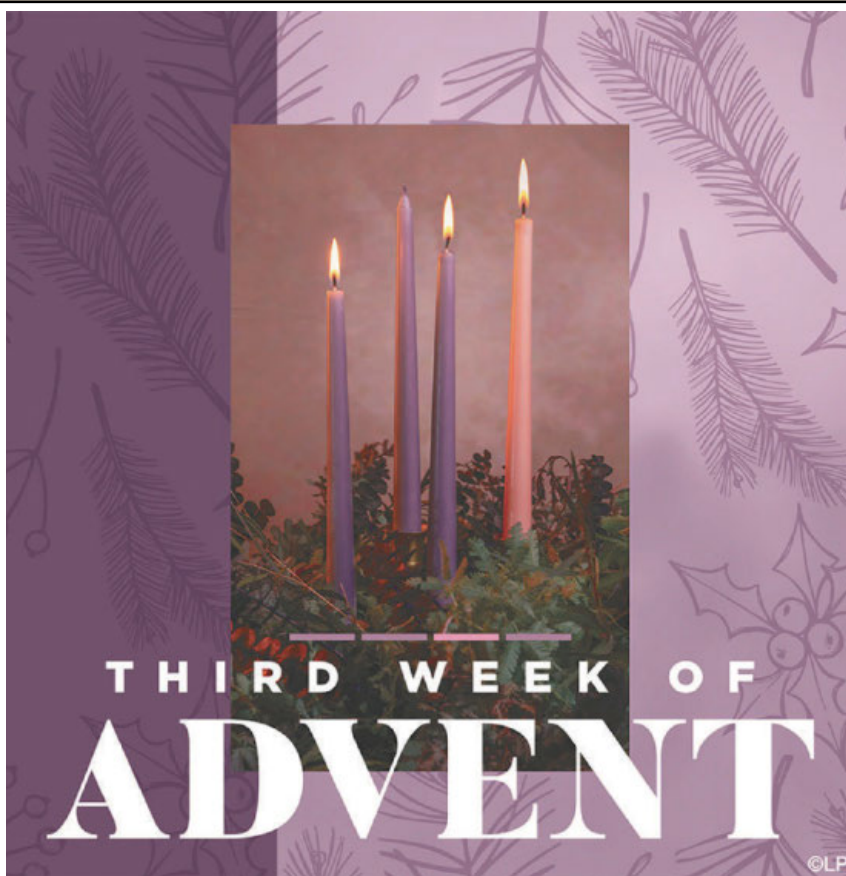

Question:

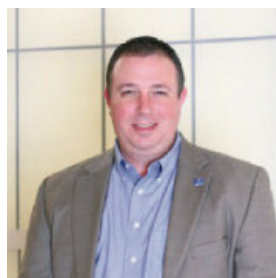

TTEF MOScholars

The state of Missouri has created a new scholarship program that directly supports Catholic education. MOScholars provides state tax credits to donors who fund private school scholarships. The program is administered by the Today and Tomorrow Educational Foundation (TTEF), our local scholarship non-profit. TTEF has enrolled 100 NEW scholars in Catholic or private school through the MOScholars program, but there is still a waiting list of nearly 200 children.
