



HEARING ASSIST DEVICES AVAILABLE

If you find it difficult to understand what is being said, we have hearing-assist devices available. A receiver and headset will provide more volume and are available at all Masses. If you would like to use a Listen Assist during any service, please ask an usher. They will show you how it works.

Several headset options are available:

- A reusable ear speaker is provided.
 It sits on the outside of your ear, and
 it is cleaned after each use
- A headset that covers both ears is available of purchase for \$2.00 It can be taken home and re-used each week.
- You may bring your own headset from home. It must have the mini plug, like those used in IPods, etc.

We ask that you please return the device after Mass. We are currently missing one of the receivers. If you happened to have taken it with you, please return it to the ushers closet next time you are at Mass so it is available for others to use.

SYMBOLS OF THE CHURCH - PART 2




Representing "Upon this rock I will build my Church", this church is standing upon a rock with troubled waters all about, imparting the strength which Christ infuses into His Church



The seven branch candlesticks here remind us of work appropriated to the Holy Spirit in the guidance of His Church. These represent the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, and the flames of the candles branch out to seven from the single central flame, which recalls the tongues of fire on the first Pentecost.



A hand mill, called the mill of the gospel, is an ancient Church symbol. This illustrates that the material needs of the Church are fulfilled by hard sacrifice, and the further spread of the gospel is made possible through the generous contributions of the faithful which are being gathered together. The mill indicates effort, and generosity, the product is a wealth of grace.



Representing the parable of the wheat and the weeds, the predominance of the wheat here illustrates the ultimate moral victory of those faithful to Christ.



WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

Question:

What are the requirements for being a confirmation sponsor?

Answer:

Although many dioceses have specific requirements for who can be a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Code of Canon Law identifies certain requirements that are true for all dioceses and parishes. First, the sponsor should be chosen by the one to be confirmed (or, in some cases, by the parents or even the pastor). Second, a sponsor must be at least sixteen years old (unless the local bishop has chosen another age, or a special exception has been made). Third, the sponsor must be a Catholic who has been confirmed and who has already received the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Beyond this, they must lead "a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on." Fourth, they can have no sort of canonical penalty or impediment. Finally, they cannot be either the father or mother of the one to be confirmed (See Canons 893, §1 and 874, §1).

In some cultures, it is customary for one of the confirmand's godparents to act as sponsor, although this is not required by Church law.

To learn about the requirements for your parish or diocese, you can consult your pastor or your parish or diocesan director of religious education or the diocese's office liturgy and worship.
