



### FROM THE PASTOR

For two and a half years, the Archdiocese of St. Louis has been preparing for a major restructuring of parishes in a process called ALL THINGS NEW. After gathering input from priests, deacons, laity, school officials and Archdiocesan offices from across the Archdiocese, the Archbishop is finally ready to present the final plan to all of us.

On the weekend of May  $27_{th}$  and  $28_{th}$ , as we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, every pastor in the Archdiocese has been instructed to announce the final outcome of the All Things New process, as it pertains to their parish, at all the weekend Masses. On Saturday, May 27, each pastor will receive an email containing information pertaining to the future status of their parish, ie. whether it remains as a stand-alone parish, shares a pastor with a neighboring parish or parishes, or is merged into another parish.

The pastor will also receive the official notification announcing whether he will be transferred to another parish, and if he is transferred, he will be notified as to which parish he will be transferred to and the name of the priest who will replace him. ALL OF THIS INFORMATION WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT ALL THE MASSES THIS WEEKEND.

Furthermore, the Archbishop will hold a press conference at 5:30pm at the Rigali Center with a general announcement, timed to coincide with the announcement at most Archdiocesan parishes.

At 6pm on Saturday evening, the future status of **every** parish in the Archdiocese and information on the transfer of **every** priest will be posted on the All Things New website and the St Louis Review website. It is anticipated that there will be a huge surge of hits on the All Things New Website on the evening of May 27. The I.T. department at the Rigali Center is working hard to prepare for this, but please be patient if you cannot immediately access the websites.

People have been asking me why this process is shrouded in such secrecy. The answer is that the Archbishop wants the parishioners of each parish to hear about the news pertaining to their parish directly from their pastor and not from some third party source which often communicates erroneous information. Any changes in parish structures or priest transfers will take effect on August 1, 2023.

As we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, we put our faith in the guidance of the Holy Spirit who reminds us that we are not alone and that no matter what happens, we are never left abandoned by Jesus.




### FEAST OF ST. FERDINAND






### A MORNING IN THE HEARTS OF JESUS AND MARY

### The Fame Communicated

"Fire! Fire! They're all gonna die! They're all gonna burn up!"

I had absolutely no hope of restoring order as I read the story of Pentecost with my young children last year. As soon as they glimpsed the tongues of fire hovering over the foreheads of the apostles, they were lost to giggles and shrieks. I sighed, sipped my coffee, and wondered resentfully why the Holy Spirit couldn't have chosen to be a dove on that particular day. Just a nice, peaceful dove.

I'll say this, though: the fire left an impression. It usually does, doesn't it? Fire consumes. It renews. It illuminates. It leaves you breathless with fear and awe. The memory and scent and impact of a flame lingers long after it is extinguished.

When I am trying to explain theology to my kids, I have an awful habit of overcomplicating things. I'd had a whole speech prepared for them about what the Holy Spirit is, but it went out the window as soon as they saw the flames. And you know what? It's probably for the best. They wouldn't have remembered that speech. The flames, though? The flames they remembered. The flame communicated.

As a result of Pentecost, the apostles suddenly had the ability to give the truth to foreigners. Aliens. People who were heretofore beyond their reach, isolated by language. The flame communicated. God's sense of timing is impeccable, and His delivery is carefully crafted. And on Pentecost, the Holy Spirit did not descend as a dove or pour forth as water.

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit burned.
