NEW ASS SCHEDULE

NEW MASS SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2023

Beginning August 1st, the present Saint Martin de Porres parish and Saint Sabina parish will become part of Saint Ferdinand parish. Part of the transition into this new reality is a new, temporary Mass schedule. *The Mass times at St. Ferdinand remain the same as before,* but the priests assigned to St. Ferdinand will also celebrate Masses at St. Martin de Porres and St. Sabina.

Beginning on Tuesday, August 1st, the Mass Schedule will be:

Weekday Masses

6:00 AM at St. Ferdinand (Monday - Friday) 8:00 AM at St. Martin de Porres (Mon - Friday) 8:00 AM at St. Ferdinand (Monday - Saturday)

Saturday Anticipated Masses

4:30 PM at St. Martin de Porres 5:00 PM at St. Ferdinand

Sunday Masses

7:00 AM at St. Ferdinand 7:30 AM at St. Sabina 9:00 AM at St. Ferdinand 10:00 AM at St. Martin de Porres 11:00 AM at St. Ferdinand 5:00 PM at St. Sabina

This Mass schedule will be effective until the end of November.

Please note that the Sunday 9:00 AM Mass at St. Patrick Apartments will be discontinued. The final Sunday Mass at St. Patrick will be July 30th.

RECTORY RENOVATION UPDATE



Dear St Ferdinand Parishioners,

Back in May of 2021 we presented a proposal to the parish to renovate and update the rectory, which is in sad shape. After we began to collect funds for this project, we were told by the Archdiocese that all construction and renovation projects would be put on hold because of the All Things New program. Now that the All Things New program has run its course and St Ferdinand will continue to exist as a parish, we have been given permission by the Archdiocese to continue renovation and construction projects.

With that being said, we would like to resurrect our rectory renovation project. I met with Fr Lijo Kallarakal, soon to be pastor of St Ferdinand and Fr Joe Banden, soon to be senior associate pastor along with Fr Nick Muenks, rectory staff members and a representative from the Archdiocesan Building and Construction office to revisit and re-design the plans that we initially had. Following a recommendation from the Archbishop, the initial tentative result of this meeting modifies our former plans and will now seek to make the rectory building a complete private residence for the priests and transfer the administrative offices and meeting rooms to the Duchesne Center which will also have to undergo some renovation to accommodate this move. The initial ideas include adding some storage space to the Duchesne center.

This project is still in the planning stage and nothing has been decided. The next step is to present an architect with ideas of what we hope can be done and then get an initial cost for the project. We still have funds that were previously contributed for this project, and we will likely ask parishioners who haven't already done so to contribute to the renovation endeavor. Sadly, I will not be here for the renovation since I am being transferred to another parish. But I hope that you will give Fr Kallarakal, Fr Banden and Fr Muenks your full support. More information will be forthcoming as it becomes available.

The Catholic Bubble

There's a dangerous myth that exists among pockets of faithful, observant Catholic families. I call it the Legend of the Catholic Bubble.

Here's how the legend goes: you find a devout Catholic parish and a devout Catholic community filled with devout Catholic people who care about devout Catholic things, and you stay away from everything and everyone else, you and your children will be safe from the influence of the evil one. Your children will never fall away from the faith, or even be tempted, and your own faith will stay steel-strong amidst the many tempests and trials of this earthly life.

But like the Loch Ness Monster and the Abominable Snowman, it's all made up.

Don't misunderstand me: I love a good devout Catholic parish. I live for a supportive, devout Catholic community. It's one of the biggest blessings in the Christian life, and I cannot overstate how helpful it is to raise children in an environment that upholds your Catholic faith and does not denigrate it.

But. But.

Make no mistake: the Catholic Bubble will not save you. The trials and the temptations will find you there, too: on the parish council, at Catholic school, in your Catholic moms' group. No community on earth is so supportive that it mimics Heaven. The weeds have been sown with the good seed, and the harvest time is not yet upon us.

Cherish your community, certainly — but beware of the lure of the Catholic Bubble. We are called to be yeast in the loaf of bread, and yeast is nothing on its own.

"And the one who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because he intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will." — Romans 8:27




"Revival" -- The bringing alive of what was dead, is something only God himself can do.

Do you want a closer relationship with our Eucharistic Lord—Jesus? He can always bring you closer to Him no matter how close you are.

- ⇒ Invite Him to enter into a deeper relationship with you. Just as He does not force us into a relationship with Him, He also doesn't force His way into a relationship with us. He waits to be invited.
- ⇒ Treat Him as you would want Him to treat you. Sometimes when something is so easy it can become routine, and we can begin to take His gifts for granted. Treat every opportunity to be with Him as if it is your last chance to be with Him.
- ⇒ Talk to Him daily and spend time in silence giving Him a chance to speak to you. All good relationships are a shared journey. Invite Him to lead you on your journey to a deeper relationship with Him.






The **Evening Quilting Group** meets on Monday evenings from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.




