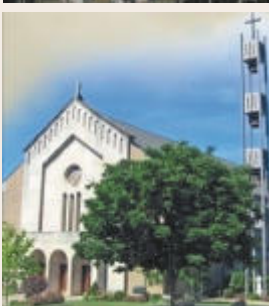

Shepherd's Call

This weekend St. Julie Billiart celebrates the anniversary of its dedication after the fire in 1994. We have much to celebrate! Many people make the parish work – PREP catechists, RCIA catechists, ministers who help before and during Mass, parents teaching their children the love of God, parishioners who witness in the community – to name a few. We are able to maintain a beautiful space to encounter God and to worship His majesty. While the date marks the dedication of a building, as we approach Beacons of Light we have to remember that a parish is a geographical territory and the Church is the people. The territory may change, but the Church and the mission remain the same.

When August 29 does not fall on a Sunday, the Catholic Church honors the witness of faith in the Beheading of John the Baptist. We can draw three lessons from this feast. First, martyrdom reminds us that faith has a cost. When we compromise the faith to acquiesce to contemporary culture, we prevent the power of God from working in us and through us. Second, we are reminded of St. John the Baptist's message, "Repent, the kingdom of God is near." When is the last time you went to confession. (For me it was this past week.) If it has been more than four or six months, heed the Baptist's cry. Third, John was beheaded on account of Herodias, who remarried to Herod Antipas after her first marriage to Herod Philip. John was willing to give his life for the sanctity of marriage as an indissoluble union between a man and a woman. I am deeply grieved at the extent to which ***we undervalue marriage*** in our own day. Please seek counsel from a priest or therapist and work to save your marriage. Please contact the church office if you divorced and intend a current or future relationship.

Este fin de semana Sta. Julia celebra el aniversario de su dedicación después del incendio de 1994. ¡Tenemos mucho que celebrar! Muchas personas hacen que la parroquia funcione: catequistas de PREP, catequistas de RICA, ministros que ayudan antes y durante la Misa, padres que enseñan a sus hijos el amor de Dios, feligreses que testifican en la comunidad, por nombrar algunos. Podemos mantener un hermoso espacio para encontrarnos con Dios y adorar Su majestuosidad. Si bien la fecha marca la dedicación de un edificio, al acercarnos a Beacons of Light "Faros de Luz" debemos recordar que una parroquia es un territorio geográfico y la Iglesia es la gente. El territorio puede cambiar, pero la Iglesia y la misión siguen siendo las mismas.

Cuando el 29 de agosto no es día domingo, la Iglesia Católica honra el testimonio de fe en la decapitación de Juan el Bautista. Podemos sacar tres lecciones de esta fiesta. Primero, el martirio nos recuerda que la fe tiene un costo. Cuando comprometemos la fe para aceptar la cultura contemporánea, evitamos que el poder de Dios obre en nosotros y a través de nosotros. En segundo lugar, se nos recuerda el mensaje de San Juan Bautista: "Arrepentíos, el reino de Dios está cerca". ¿Cuándo fue la última vez que se confesó? (Para mí fue la semana pasada). Si han pasado más de cuatro o seis meses, escuche el grito de Juan el Bautista. En tercer lugar, Juan fue decapitado a causa de Herodías, quien se volvió a casar con Herodes. Antipas después de su primer matrimonio con Herodes Felipe. John estaba dispuesto a dar su vida por la santidad del matrimonio como unión indisoluble entre un hombre y una mujer. Estoy profundamente apenado por la medida en que subestimamos el matrimonio en nuestros días. Busque el consejo de un sacerdote o terapeuta y trabaje para salvar su matrimonio. Comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia si se divorció y tiene la intención de tener una relación actual o futura.

PREP—Parish Religious Education Program

PREP – Pastoral Region Religious Education Program

On Sunday, Sept. 12 classes begin in the Fenmont. All parents attend classes with their children for the first class from **10:20 to 11:30 am**. This is a time change due to Mass being at a different time than in the past. We ask families to register now so that the first day goes smoothly. Classes are offered for K – 12 students. Those wishing to prepare for a sacrament need to attend for two full years of PREP. Our next Confirmation will be in 2023 for those who will be in grade 7 on up. All those entering the Fenmont need to wear a mask during PREP time.

Starting Sept. 19 – all those coming to the Fenmont for PREP should check in St. Julie Hall First. Each Sunday students will wait in St. Julie large Hall until their teacher arrives.

Catechetical Sunday – On Sept. 19 we ask all those who teach the Catholic Faith to come to the altar to receive a blessing when Father calls you up. Please keep our catechists in your prayers as they join with parents to pass on our faith.

SAFE PARISH – Look for your required quarterly training around Sept. 1

All VIRTUS TRAINED volunteers and staff MUST transfer over to SafeParish by Sept. 1. Use the password **protectcincy** to register into the www.catholicaoc.org SafeParish to transfer your files from VIRTUS to SafeParish.

Weekly Emails

Each Tuesday SafeParish sends an email regarding the updated child protection and workplace safety articles that are posted on the SafeParish website. These articles are NOT required but are recommended reading.

Quarterly Bulletins

The first bulletin should be issued around September 1st. Emails will come from SafeParish notifying users of the quarterly training which will also appear in their account under training that is due. Users can check for training that is due after logging into their SafeParish account by going to the Training Tab and click on the 'Due' link to see which bulletins are due and their due date.

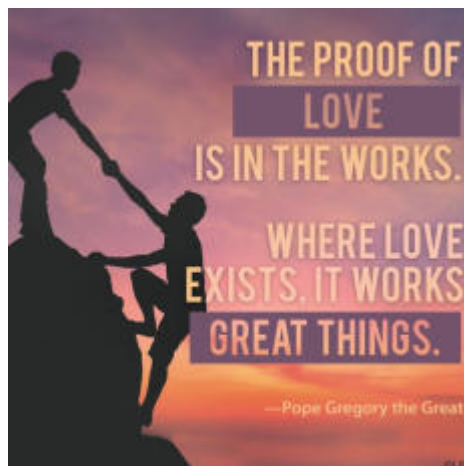

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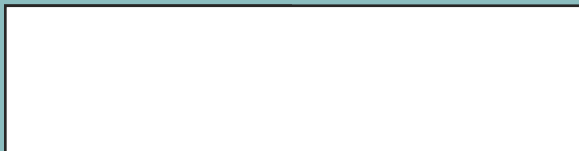
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
