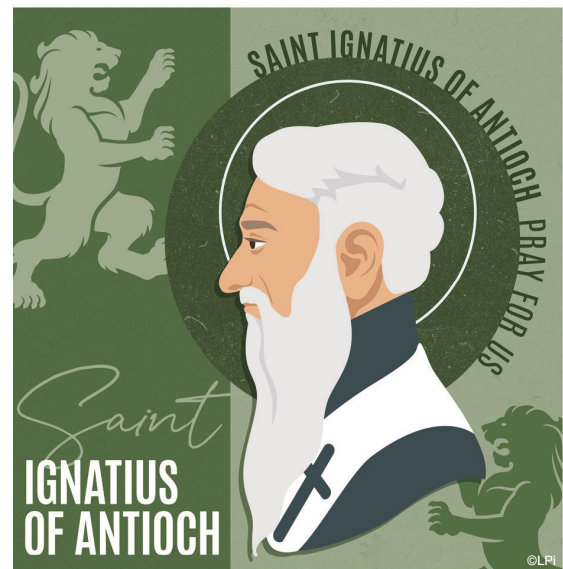

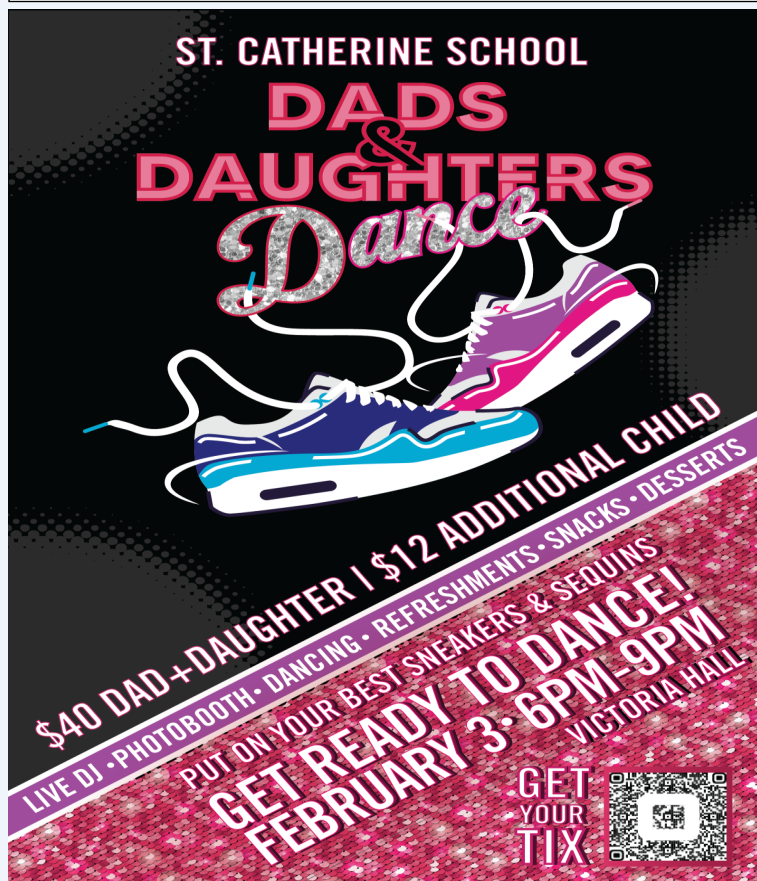

Faith and Racial Healing Course: Embracing Truth, Justice, and Restoration

Our Lady of the Lake Church,

Jubilee Hall, 8900 – 35th Avenue N E, Seattle, WA 98115

April 6, 2024, through May 28, 2024

This program explains the historical context behind the racial inequalities we face today, whether in education, the criminal justice system, the workforce, or even in church life. Though we focused specifically on enslaved Africans and their descendants, this program will open participants' eyes to patterns of injustice that affect other minority groups across the nation as well. Through the one-day opening retreat, immersion experience, and eight sessions, your group will emerge from Faith and Racial Healing better equipped to work toward restoration. Recommended group size: 9-15.

Cost – Course \$35.00 + Books \$43.00 = \$78.00

Registration: Open from January 2024 – February 29, 2024, participants individually register on-line with Just Faith Ministries and pay based on a sliding fee scale of \$35, \$55, or \$75/person (your choice). 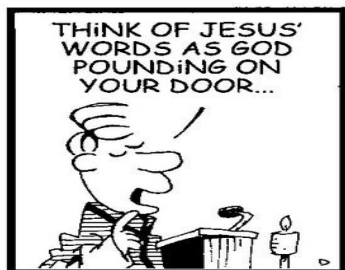
