

Matthew 28:16–20
Jesus commands us to go and baptize.

Every year on this feast, we hear the opening passage from Acts of the Apostles, in which Luke writes that Jesus is lifted up as the disciples look on. Interestingly, in Matthew's Gospel, Jesus leads the disciples up a mountain but does not disappear from their sight. However, both Matthew and Luke emphasize that Jesus gave the disciples a mission: to be his witnesses, evangelizing to the ends of the earth. May we listen to Jesus' words as his modern-day disciples, ready and eager to hear his guidance.

Among Catholics, May is most well-known as "Mary's Month," a specific month of the year when special devotions are performed in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Why is that? How did May become associated with the Blessed Mother? There are many different factors that contributed to this association. First of

all, in ancient Greece and Rome the month of May was dedicated to pagan goddesses connected to fertility and springtime (Artemis and Flora, respectively). This, combined with other European rituals commemorating the new season of spring, led many Western cultures to view May as a month of life and motherhood. This was long before "Mother's Day" was ever conceived, though the modern celebration is closely related to this innate desire to honor maternity during the spring months





- An adult to help
- 4 cotton balls
- Blue plastic cup
- Glue
- Scissors
- White paper
- Markers or crayons
- Fishing line (about 14")
- Paper clip

What you do:

- 1. Set the cup upside down. Pull apart the cotton balls, forming cloud shapes, and glue them around the cup.
- 2. With an adult's help, poke a hole in the bottom of the cup.
- 3. On the paper, draw and cut out a Jesus figure. Color both sides.
- 4. Poke a hole atop Jesus, string fishing line through the hole and tie a knot.
- 5. String the other end through the hole in the cup. Tie the end to a paper clip.
- 6. Pull up the paper clip to take Jesus into the clouds.
